


(The last Canto reviewed by Sri Aurobindo before his departure in 1950)

One voice that questioned changeless destiny,

It turned the straight path hewn by the body's gods,

With the arrow-point of being's inmost sight,
Marred the sure steps of Nature's simple walk
And truth and freedom in the growing soul.

Out of some ageless innocence and peace,
Privilege of souls not yet betrayed to birth,
Cast down to suffer on this hard dangerous earth
Our life was born in pain and with a cry.

Although earth-nature welcomes heaven's breath
Inspiring Matter with the will to live,
A thousand ills assail the mortal's hours
And wear away the natural joy of life;
Our bodies are an engine cunningly made,
But for all its parts as cunningly are planned,
Contrived ingeniously with demon skill,

Its apt inevitable heritage
Of mortal danger and peculiar pain,
Its payment of the tax of Time and Fate,
Its way to suffer and its way to die.

This is the ransom of our high estate, The sign and stamp of our humanity.

A grisly company of maladies
Come, licensed lodgers, into man's bodily house,
Purveyors of death and torturers of life.
In the malignant hollows of the world,
In its subconscient cavern-passages
Ambushed they lie waiting their hour to leap,
Surrounding with danger the sieged city of life:
Admitted into the citadel of man's days
They mine his force and maim or suddenly kill.
Ourselves within us lethal forces nurse;
We make of our own enemies our guests:

Out of their holes like beasts they creep and gnaw
The chords of the divine musician's lyre
Till frayed and thin the music dies away
Or crashing snaps with a last tragic note.

All that we are is like a fort beset:
All that we strive to be alters like a dream
In the grey sleep of Matter's ignorance.
Mind suffers lamed by the world's disharmony
And the unloveliness of human things.

BCC Recovery Report

BCC team was told by C&AG of India to recover all dues of up to 31 March 2023 latest by 31 March 2024. Questions were raised about non-compliance of CoC2017 (of levying 1% extra contribution per month of non-payment of the dues!), besides the large accumulation of past dues itself.

We wish to express heartfelt gratitude to all those who cooperated in this exercise. All those who approached us (even to tell that they do not have money to pay!) because communication of 'inability to pay' has been definitely noted separately from 'unwillingness to pay and lack of communication.'

Some of the units/ services/ activities have been closed since this exercise began (and will continue being closed) with their dues unpaid, as they have either expressed their inability to pay and wish to continue their operations OR not expressed anything at all.

Some units/ services/ activities have started recurring transfers.

In some cases money has been transferred to another service/ unit but not to BCC and we have approached the auditors for their input on the same.

There may not be a need for such an exercise in the coming years. It needs to be clearly understood that 'past dues' will not be permitted to accumulate in this manner and as such we would not be having funds coming in bulk like this.

Here's the update about the 'Contribution Recovery' exercise that we have concluded for now, which has been presented to the FAMC and will be handed over to the Office of Secretary of the Auroville Foundation (OSAF). Any further action, if necessary, needs to be taken by them. Following figures are the dues until the end of 2023 (and in some cases from as far back as 2013 onwards):

- Total dues recovered (some units have paid their full dues and others have paid their partial dues. This aspect is noted in the database but not part of this report): Rs.748.15 lakhs
- 2. Incorrect calculations (it could be because of an incorrect contribution rate used OR changed contribution rate abruptly without ever canceling the due amount OR lack of clarity in the balance sheet OR genuine miscalculation): Rs.95.40 lakhs
- 3. Bad debt or irrecoverable: Rs.212.95 lakhs
- Request waiver/ not responding (these have been separated in the database but not in this report): Rs.67.32 lakhs

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF REPORT (Fy' 23—24)

Financial Year 2023—24 brought into question the Standard Operating Procedures and Policies which the BCC Office has followed for all of its financial transactions. These are under scrutiny by Internal Auditors.

Comptroller & Account General (C&AG) conducted Audit of BCC related Financial Service Accounts, procedures and Policies. Mainly all our Payments done to Service Units and Collection from the furtherance Units.

It was recorded by CAG that Nos of Units failed to transfer the City Service contribution in a timely manner in the last 10 years. As per the Code of Conduct approved by Auroville Foundation and Fund & Assets Management Committee, Units are supposed to pay the 'contribution by 30 June of the next financial year' and 'outstanding contribution payments that are not settled by September 1st are liable for additional contributions at 1% per month'.

BCC Team undertook a monumental effort for deriving the last ten years of pending contributions by scrutinizing calculations from the balance sheets available in different formats for the last ten years to find out the pending city service contributions.

Total collection figure in the report represents all the pending contributions of the last 10 years. Total income received in the Financial Year 22—23 is Rs. 30.02 Cr.

Total Payment Disbursed is 25.65 Cr of which total maintenance disbursed is 17.55 cr. Recurring Budget 6.42 Cr. (Apart from this there were also non-recurring expenses and other expenses which were disbursed).

In the financial year 2022—23, the City Services Reserves went 28% down from Rs 10.26 Cr to Rs 7.35 Cr. During the financial year 2023—24, the CS Reserves raised by 57% thanks to an increase in 16,85% in Collection and a 9% reduction in the total payments (compared with the total of the previous year) after reviewing of operations by FAMC and BCC.

It was the first time in the history of BCC that a Balance sheet for City Services supported units were prepared and Executives were asked to sign the documents which were submitted to Auroville Foundation.

Auditors pointed out that each Unit Activity needs to be registered under a Trust. BCC Office cannot be the umbrella recording the accounts of the Unit. BCC would prioritize this task of registering such units under relevant Trust. One of them is Auroville Health Fund which was not registered under any trust. Process has been initiated and soon AVHF will be registered under the Health and Healing Trust.

It was observed that the BCC current system lacks data accuracy and authenticity which is a highest hurdle in bringing efficiency in the processes. To overcome the challenge AVICAS accounting has been introduced by AVF and FAMC which will resolve the current challenges in near future.

With the support of Auroville Integrated Information Services (AIIS), BCC started working on an online web platform to follow the visa application for non-Indians and steps related to issuance of a 'No Dues Certificate'. Users of the portal are Auroville Foundation, Working committee and BCC Office. This brings transparency and efficiency in the process of issuing the visa.

An effort has been made to collect the supporting information of Parents receiving maintenance for the children. 67 parents are yet to submit their information after sending frequent and several reminders.

BCC observed that implementation of Silver Fund Policy was never endorsed by the community or the Fund & Asset Management committee. Because of this reason BCC had to stop new enrolments under this budget head. BCC requested recipients to share their basic information to BCC for the record purpose. Total 97 Adults are receiving Silver Fund maintenance. BCC has not received the information

from 31 Adult individuals who are receiving support from BCC for the Silver Fund.

BCC shared the details with FAMC of these individuals who have shown non-cooperation in this process. The whole issue of senior support and proper policy for it is in draft review pending final review and approval by FAMC and approval by the Governing Board.

Questions raised by FAMC on productivity and efficiency of Farms and Forest. Both, Farms and Forests are engaged in commercial activity. BCC has been asked to release the care package for individuals working in Farms and Forest till the complete Food and Green buffer Sector work plan is clear and mutually agreed between Farms and FAMC.

Joint efforts were made along with FAMC and SAIIER to review and rework the budgets disbursed to sub units under SAIIER oversight. There was a proposal to merge or close some of the units whose assets were underutilized at the same time needing a regular operational budget. These changes will be implemented at the beginning of the next Academic year.

Regular monthly disbursements were made to Auroville Dental Centre and Auroville Health Service for their services to Aurovilian. BCC continues reimbursing the expenditure for Visa application fees for non-Indians.

Revamping the budget for the Education Unit and Health Sector would be of prime importance for the coming financial year.

The Mother always emphasized on Karma Yoga. Individuals are supposed to engage in full time work as a Sadhana apart from taking care of their home, individual needs, children etc. BCC observed there are people working only half time. This culture leads to the units under minimum performance and growth and progress are not at par with the standard which can represent the new world. In coming time BCC would recommend a policy and process where each individual must be a part of service to Auroville through full time work.

Auroville must be an example to the world of demonstrating Sincerity towards the work and work needs to be done in the spirit of Karma Yoga. BCC observed that so far accountability and responsibility is missing in the work culture broadly and that has led to creation of Nos of Miscellaneous maintenance categories where individuals were supported without any contribution through work and were never questioned. BCC is aspiring to bring accountability and transparency in the process with the spirit of service to the Truth.





AN ANNOUNCEMENT FROM TLC (The Learning Community)

Dear community, we would like to inform the wider community that in a meeting called by SAIIER board on Wednesday 17th April, TLC (The Learning Community), was informed that SAIIER has decided to withdraw all financial support for TLC (facilitators' maintenances and running budget) and reclaim all assets accumulated over the years. We were also told that we will need to vacate TLC Base Camp by July '24.

TLC has been under the SAIIER umbrella for many years, categorized as a 'middle school'. Those who know us understand well that we clearly do not fit this definition. We are not a school. We are a community of learners, working with all ages, from nursery to adult education, as well carrying out research projects in Integral Education.

While this news has come as a shock, and there is sadness and a sense of loss, we feel that this is an opportunity for TLC to finally embark on the journey we have known for some time will benefit our community.

Discontinuing under the SAIIER umbrella will enable us to continue our active research in Integral Education without having to justify or compromise on our visions, goals and their implementation, which clearly do not fit with the definitions of a school as set down by SAIIER.

We have met with TLC's parents and facilitators to share and reflect on this new phase of TLC, and to update the community on our ideas for a way forward. The news brought up a mix of surprise and sadness, together with positive energy and a will to move into this next phase with inspiration and joy, believing in our capacity to flourish and grow from this experience, adults and children alike.

It was clear that all present know that TLC is not Base Camp! It is much much more There are many practical aspects of this new phase to work out. We are in communication with FAMC to move TLC to an alternate umbrella. Here too, we have met with much resistance and blockages, yet we are determined and feel able to move through this period with grace and gratitude, and find solutions to enable the continued growth of this beautiful project which has undergone a deep journey of 16 years. We aspire to continue and deepen within the Auroville context of unending education and a laboratory of research into human consciousness and evolution.

We have faith, trust and feel Her support and guidance. We reach out to our wider Auroville community for your support, be it in your love and good wishes or in any practical way you would like to offer help



 - Be aware that CRIPA is a space for performing arts and related activities: theater, dance and music.
 - Welcome and deal with people. Reply to phone and email inquiries from Auroville and outside.
 - Organize the schedules effectively, impartially and fairly. Maintaining weekly (or monthly) schedule for users. Be sharp, check often and update changes.
 - Make sure that the hall and all facilities are in good condition and ready for use.
 - Together with the technician, the person helps organize and prepare the room for performances and other events; lights set up, sound set up, props, acoustic templates.
 - Create announcements for News and Auronet, posters, etc for performances and other events (workshops, festivals...)
 - Follow up/supervise the amma's work and pay wages.
 - Follow up/supervise the watchman and pay wages.
 - Receive payment and deposit to our account.
 - Keep all accounts for SAIIER (equipment, repairs) and BCC (maintenance and running costs).
 - Organize and supervise the purchasing of equipment and summer repairs yearly, following all the steps SAIIER requires.
 - Communicate with SAIIER. Keep records, history and files, of activities for SAIIER: writing the annual report.
 - Help to create a CRIPA website on the main AV website, Art & Culture section.
 - Participate in regular CRIPA meetings (once weekly).





Travel Tips

- Several travelers were 'boarding denied' as check-in staff didn't accept the e-FRRO Stay Visa as valid document without backing it up with additional documentation. Therefore we advise to take beside the Stay Visa document (please make sure your current Passport details are in it) your Original Visa, which is maybe in an older expired Passport. If not available anymore, take at least a photocopy of the original Visa.
- Indian nationals can now be issued long-term, multientry Schengen visas valid for two years after having obtained and lawfully used two visas within the previous three years. The two-year visa will normally be followed by a five-year visa, if the passport has sufficient validity remaining. During the validity period of these visas, holders enjoy travel rights equivalent to visa-free nationals.
- Sri Lanka has shifted from the Electronic Travel Authentication (ETA) visa programme to a new E-visa scheme with effect from 17 April 2024. In this context, the ETA website was discontinued on 16 April 2024
- The Embassy of the Republic of Turkey announces that Turkish authorities has commenced requiring the 'Electronic Airport Transit Visa' (e-ATV) for Indian & Nepalese passport holders traveling to Mexico, Panama, Colombia and Venezuela, Transiting via the Istanbul Airport.

TWO TO TANGO

On the Ideological Tango: As the sayings go, 'It takes two to tango.' and 'The more the merrier.' In the Dance of Ideologies, there are two main players in the global scene:

1. The False-Separative Ideology

- Characterized by the egomind or gross mental consciousness-force, which perceives and feels itself separate from the rest of creation.
- What is this egomind exactly and how does it persist?
 'Ego persists because of three things; first because we
 think we are the body; secondly because of desire; and

They crucified him and the Romans hijacked and distorted his revelation of love and oneness for egoistic power, control and global domination. History speaks for itself. His true legacy though endures in its purest form.

2. The Truth-Unity Ideology

- Characterized by the Supermind or Supramental Consciousness-Force, which perceives and feels all as Its Self.
- There is One God, and That is you, and definitely also your neighbor who has the right to worship any other extensions and manifestations of this One God. Thus the love in oneness. Unity in diversity. You are unique amongst uniques, and acknowledged, including the false-separative in their ongoing self-corrective mirrordance. Each perfectly plays one's unique yet mutable role in the hierarchical Play of the One Absolute Eternal and Infinite, with the Supreme Divine Mother Maha-Shakti as Creatrix, Director, Modulator and Transformer of Her innumerable children, all integral sparks of the One. MISQUOTING THE MOTHER? The Yin-Yang Layout

The Mother and Roger are often misquoted. A recurrent case is the yin-yang model, even at the recent community meeting the Secretary called. No, the Mother did not discard it. It is Roger who, out of it, evolved the Galaxy.

The yin-yang layout—the second one the Mother approved—was reproduced in the Ashram



'Bulletin' of November 1967, printed for Darshan. It was vividly described in two famous interviews winning over many people: '= 1', in 1967; and the 'Journal of the Indian Institute of Architects' (JIIA), in 1971! The lines of force in the Galaxy substituted the two macrostructures, but the dynamism of the spiraling concept remained as the one keystone.

Roger presented to the Mother what will be known as 'the Galaxy' only in January 1968. Postcards of the yin-yang model had already been printed, with Mother's handwritten message 'Auroville the Town of the Future'.

Auroville was born in the sixties, those years nothing was deemed impossible. Macro buildings mimicking towns were the symbol of that age and Paolo Soleri was a sign-post; invited by Piero Cicionesi (the Matrimandir in site architect), the celebrated architect visited Auroville and a few Aurovilians settled in Arcosanti. The yin-yang layout, banning all cars while featuring a circular monorail supra elevated, many bodies of water (a constant, in Roger's vision), and wondrous descriptions of spaces and habitats, belong to that bold era. When I asked Roger why a so fantastic layout was abandoned, his answer was simple: he kept working on the concept because the two megastructures, where most inhabitants would live, hampered the sight of Matrimandir. This is how the Galaxy, whose main feature is the lines of force, was born. Just in time for Foundation Day.

These excerpts from the interview by Luigi and Aryamani, on 10.3.1996, explain how Roger, using as starting point the dynamic yin-yang model the Mother had approved, evolved the Galaxy:

R.: '... I brought her another concept which was interesting—which started to be a little more dynamic, which started spinning a little.

L.: The beginning of the Galaxy, but with two long lines of force.

R.: Like Yin and Yang, there were two energies.

L.: Two lines of force which hid the view of Matrimandir—the view of the centre.

R.: It hid it without hiding it; but it enclosed the Matrimandir in a kind of valley with buildings around it which locked it in somewhat. It was interesting but it was a mega-structure. It was extremely theoretical but what was interesting was that the beginning of the Galaxy was there. So, I showed it to Mother. I must say that I felt it was not up to the mark when I showed it to her. She did not say anything... She said it was interesting but I could feel that it had not reached its potential. I also felt it had established something but that it wasn't entirely there as yet. So the whole team worked on it again. It took another six months—one year—rather six months. I worked on it at Théméricourt, an estate I had in the countryside. We withdrew for months and worked on project number two. I worked a lot with Charles Gianferrari. ...

A.: So, you were saying that you had reached a point with this team of finding the lines of force.

R.: Yes, we came up with the Galaxy concept. Then it was only a question of working things out. We made two models, we thought about the type of buildings. After that everything flowed smoothly. When something comes like that, naturally, it is a good sign. There was nothing to discuss. We knew that we had come upon the answer. We knew that we had come into contact with something that was the essence. I went back [to India] with a model which was the small model at that time—and I came to see Mother—and Mother found it.... This time it was accomplished. She said, 'It is a movement of nebula which already exists... in the cosmos.' For us it was an achievement. And the Galaxy, I don't know who gave it this name. It remained the Galaxy. ...'

PASSING ON: MARTIN

Martin was an amazing man: generous of spirit, hard-working, and dedicated to the people and projects that he had committed to. He originally arrived in Auroville in 1997 with his family from Switzerland—Nadja, Luca and David.



For the past 12 years he has been an integral part of the Botanical garden team, tending to the Plumerias and other garden areas he had created, as well as welcoming and mentoring so many of the volunteers who came to the gardens. When one walks through the central area of the gardens, from the plumerias to the main pond and back through the bamboo area, one can appreciated the manifested beauty of his karma yoga.

But his life in Auroville has been far wider and richer than just these years at the Botanical gardens. He, along with Shivakala his wife, contributed to the lives of so many, taking responsibility to support and guide youngsters from the local area through college, providing for them a safe and secure home to grow up in. Some came as young as five years of age, others came when they were a little older, but all told, there are more than ten young ladies in the world today who have received the love and support of Martin in their lives and through their education – in their own words:

'He took us into his arms and raised us as his own child. Never did we feel that we are an outsider to the family.'

'Not only a father, a good friend, and a mentor. We and this universe are going to miss such a wonderful human being. We love u dad. I love u my better half.'

'He fulfilled the role of father perfectly in our life and gave us a meaningful future. The soul who smiles and hugs each time, making us to feel secure whatever problem you have'

'He created a family bond without blood relations but a family that is connected by heart and soul fully' 'He had taught us everything in life. He taught us of how to respect, love, care and be responsible. Without him we are nothing. All our stepping stones to success is filled with his sacrifice and love.'

'Martin had a heart of gold. Thank you Martin, you've made the world a better place'

He also for many years ran the kitchen at New Creation School, always with his happy smile and cheery countenance, making sure that all the kids were well fed. His connection to New Creation was preceded by his first port of call which was Forecomers nursery, where he took charge after Ed had left, and after the kitchen he was for many years at the nursery in Matrimandir, where he developed his passion for the Plumerias and enthused everyone with his love for plants.

He had a great appreciation for the landscape of Tamil Nadu and was particularly attracted to the rocky landscapes of Gingee where he has created a sanctuary forest – a place he would often retreat to at the weekends to spend time in quiet reflection as well as working to develop the area.

He was quite simply a wonderful example of how one can be in this magical place called Auroville. A person who took full responsibility for life and lived it to the full, making the space we live a better place for everyone. He will be very sorely missed.

Love and strength to Shivakala and his large family. Martin, thank you. Be in peace.
