



Satprem: I would like very much to ask you something... Why did he have to go?

Mother: Ah! That can't be told.

(long silence)

I can tell you why, but in a purely superficial way... Because for him to do IMMEDIATELY—without leaving his body, that is—what he had to do, well...

(silence)

We can put it this way: the world was not ready. But to tell you the truth, it was the totality of things around him that was not ready. So when he SAW this (I only understood this afterwards), he saw that it would go much faster if he were not there.

And he was ABSOLUTELY right, it was true.

Once I saw that, I accepted. When I saw it, when he made me understand, I accepted; otherwise...

Everything was left hanging until the moment he made me understand the COMPLETE thing, in its entirety... But that's for later on.

ILLEGITIMATE ATTEMPT AGAIN TO DESTROY PROPERTY

We are writing following the unannounced and illegitimate attempt today to again destroy property of the Auroville Foundation near the proposed Crown Rd, the bathroom of Elodie and Txuma. The existing building has the appropriate approvals and no alternative to the basic infrastructure required has been made available, despite numerous commitments on your part.

It is understood that following proper planning, as per the National Green Tribunal judgment the full section of the Crown area will need to be assessed and detailed development plans produced, and eventually existing structures have to be seen within that strategic context.

Yet, in the absence of due authority, proper planning, internal processes and natural justice you have no grounds to initiate or enforce such actions. It is subjudice and will be brought to the attention of the honorable courts.

We again urge you to respect the unequivocal position of the Residents' Assembly and abandon the course of destruction and division, you do not represent Auroville or its Residents. The City the Earth Needs cannot and will not be manifested this way.

Dear Community, we want to update you on our response to the on-going attempts to enforce a narrow vision for Auroville and its physical manifestation. As many of you are already aware, the Secretary of the Auroville Foundation, assisted by a few Aurovilians, have been trying to equate The Dream of Mother with the mere construction and population of a city.

Most recently this can be seen in the haphazard attempts to replace existing stretches of road, and laying of new sections following the forceful clearance of forest sections and demolition of buildings.

The Madras High Court (MHC) Judgement and Emergency Residents' Assembly Decision (RAD) result:

The recent MHC judgement has affirmed the legitimacy of the Residents' Assembly's working groups. The recently concluded Emergency RAD following the judgement showed unprecedented participation and unity in the face of the on-going adversity. Although the judgement is 'stayed' (paused) following the appeal submission against it by the Secretary for the Auroville Foundation, the position of the community remains clear and we continue our work to the best of our ability.

The 'Pause Crown' RAD, the Working Committee RAD and this most recent resolution are being ignored by those trying to force their idea of Auroville by use of power. Instead of 'accelerating' the construction of the city, this disconnect only hinders the integral planning and unfolding of the international township. We remain committed to "working with the community to define a way forward for Auroville's development" We are exploring participatory frameworks such as those used in the dreamweaving and others for doing so. You will hear more about it in our next monthly report.

The "construction" of the Crown road in the Bliss/ Youth Centre area and on the earlier paved stretches (RZ Sector 1, Kalabhoomi, near Svedam):

The ongoing substandard work (as evidenced [by the reports of Satprem](#)) in the Bliss/ Youth Centre area (also going against the above mentioned RAD) and the absolutely unnecessary destruction of the existing stretches of the paved areas of the Crown have been commissioned directly by the Secretary, Auroville Foundation to the Central Public Works Department (CPWD), rather than through the illegitimate 'ATDC'.

The RA-selected TDC and Working Committee have written to the Ministry of Education, Central Public Works Department, the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, and the Governing Board raising safety and access concerns along with the waste of public funds.

Attempted destruction of Elodie & Txuma's bathroom

Without notice or basic precautions there was an attempt to tear down the bathroom of Elodie & Txuma which sits alongside the proposed Crown road, a letter on this is published separately for your information

National Green Tribunal next steps

The Joint Committee established by the NGT for prescribing how the crown RoW is to be built taking into consideration trees and water bodies, has submitted its report, which is going to be heard in the follow up case issued against the AVFO for defying the initial judgement. The report is lacking in many aspects, such as only looking at the Darkali area rather than the whole 4.3 kilometres but also by lacking an understanding of the forest ecosystem and the watershed. A counter to the report has been filed and will be heard on September 8.

We strongly oppose any action that would support similar destruction in Darkali as occurred in Bliss & Youth Center. In these uncertain times and with court hearings on-going, we are striving to navigate the complexity with a smile, and we invite you to join us in this practice of patience as a lot of work necessarily continues behind the scenes.

RESOLUTION OF THE RESIDENTS' ASSEMBLY Emergency RAD of August 2022

Preamble

In recent months, a series of Office Orders, along with 2 Standing Orders for the FAMC and the TDC, have been issued by the Office of the Secretary. The Auroville Foundation Act, 1988, mandates that the Residents' Assembly of Auroville be involved in the governance of Auroville and consequently in the process of appointments. This has been the practice ever since inception. Unfortunately, the stance of the present Secretary has forced Residents of Auroville to seek legal recourse to establish and reinforce the intent and purpose of the Auroville Foundation Act, 1988.

In light of the recent ruling by the Madras High Court dated 12.8.2022, the Residents' Assembly of Auroville is committed to affirming the organisational structure of the Auroville Foundation consisting of the Governing Board, the International Advisory Council, the Residents' Assembly and the Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly, which must work together in a spirit of "true brotherhood" leading to "mutuality". Through this resolution, we – the Residents' Assembly – affirm our deep faith and commitment to develop Auroville in accordance with the Auroville Charter and the philosophy of our founders the Mother and Sri Aurobindo. We accept and welcome with gratitude the judgment of the Hon'ble Madras High Court.

The present Resolution is being passed with respect to the sentiments expressed by the Madras High Court, in a spirit of cooperation and collective decision-making, with the hope that it will bring us closer to the ideals and aspirations set out in the Auroville Charter.

Resolution

- **We understand** that the Madras High Court in its judgement dated 12.8.2022 has reaffirmed that "under the Auroville Foundation, Auroville will be administered by the people of Auroville", "to [the] benefit of the residents of Auroville who abide by the Auroville Charter" and that we are responsible for the development of Auroville with the supervisory guidance of the Governing Board and the International Advisory Council. **We accept** the verdict of the Hon'ble Madras High Court and hereby resolve that we shall follow the letter and spirit of the judgement. **We request and direct** our Working Committee to take the necessary steps to implement the said judgement.

- **We reject** any existing or future Office Orders related to any entity (such as Trusts, Units, Committees, Working Groups, Services) functioning under the Residents' Assembly, that is passed without consultation with or approval of the Residents' Assembly, directly or through its Working Committee, as is required by the AVF Act, the AVF Rules, and their interpretation by the Madras High Court in its judgement dated 12.8.2022.
- **We affirm** our trust and confidence in our functioning Committees, Working Groups and Services and confirm the members as per the Annexure 2 attached who were selected by the Residents' Assembly either directly, or by means and procedures approved by it. **We direct** the Financial Service and Unity Fund to continue to function only and exclusively under the direction of the RA-selected FAMC and the Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly.
- **We are conscious** that the Madras High Court has directed us not to take any policy decisions till the Register of Residents is updated in accordance with the Auroville Foundation Act, 1988 (AVF Act), and the Auroville Foundation Rules, 1997 (AVF Rules). **We hereby direct** strict compliance with the same. We hope that all the other statutory bodies of the Auroville Foundation will follow the aforementioned direction.
- In light of the sentiments expressed by the Madras High Court and in the spirit of cooperation, **we request** the Governing Board, with the support of the International Advisory Council, to immediately direct recall of all Office Orders and Standing Orders in Annexure 1 which were issued without consultation with the Residents' Assembly or their duly elected Working Groups. The names mentioned in the listed Committees and Office Orders in Annexure 1 were neither nominated nor selected by the Residents' Assembly.
- Keeping in mind the directions of the Hon'ble Madras High Court, **we instruct** that our Working Groups shall not take any policy decisions till the updation of the Register of Residents but **will continue** to ensure and reaffirm the governance structure of the Auroville Foundation as stipulated in the AVF Act and the AVF Rules, in compliance with the judgement of the Madras High Court dated 12.8.2022.
- **We further empower and direct** our Working Committee to assist the Residents of Auroville in the process of the updation of the Register of Residents in strict compliance with the AVF Act and the AVF Rules. **We request** the Secretary of the Auroville Foundation to extend the same cooperation to our Working Committee and bona fide Working Groups and ensure the updation of the Register of Residents in accordance with the AVF Act and the AVF Rules and in compliance with the direction of the Hon'ble Madras High Court in its judgement dated 12.8.2022.
- **We reserve the right** to intervene and recall, or if necessary, ratify the decisions or members of the Working Groups in accordance with the AVF Act, AVF Rules and previous resolutions and rules of this Assembly.
- After the passing of this Resolution in accordance with the rules and procedures of this Assembly, **we direct** our Working Committee to take all necessary steps to ensure implementation of the decision of the Madras High Court. **We authorize** the Working Committee selected by the Residents' Assembly (Aravinda, Bharathy, Chali, Hemant, Mael, Sauro, Valli) to sign this Resolution on behalf of the Residents' Assembly.

Dear community, as you may recall we published a first follow-up report to you in the 11 August N&N and on the ForAll Intranet site.

You certainly gave us a lot to think about, on top of everything else that's going on. Thank you!

In our last report we said we were thinking about a follow-up meeting with the residents. We still don't quite know when that will be, having participated in the 'Emergency' meeting at Kalabhumi on Saturday 13 August and having been actively involved in the Emergency RAD that was initiated by the Working Committee after that.

What we're setting up now is 'open house' hours, like our Working Committee, Auroville Council, and Town Development Council (TDC). We have some space in the former Koodam office, along with our brothers and sisters in the Working Committee. As soon as we have confirmation we'll let you know.

From your questions, we have added to our agenda two very important topics that were brought to us, namely:

1. How to teach and help units flourish and to bring more income to AV
2. How will the FAMC support Aurovilians who may need to relocate temporarily due to visa issues?

Concerning question number 2 above our initial response is that this is a discussion for a wider group of people. We need to get inputs from the Working Committee, and the Budget Coordination Committee, for example.

Someone brought up a concern about the 'absence of core skills' in groups. We definitely agree that individuals' and groups' skills can be improved and are essential. We have responded to the individual accordingly, which included this statement, 'We are working on identifying these resources within and outside our working group and wish to work on sharing and learning these core skills as we move forward.'

We finished the list of inquiries, the last few of which were more individual in nature. We've followed up on those.

COMMUNICATION TO COMMUNITY

Dear Community, we were recently informed about a regrettable incident that happened to two young women on one of the isolated access roads, between Puducherry ECR and La Ferme, Auroville around 11:30pm at night.

In light of this assault and attempted robbery, we wish to advise again Aurovilians, Newcomers, Volunteers and Guests against travelling on those types of isolated roads after nightfall, alone or even as a couple, as those roads are unsafe, especially at night time.

We would like to remind all Auroville units and communities who hire watchmen and employees that the prevention and care of people in need, especially in case of emergency, must be provided by these employees within their abilities. We would request all/everyone to ensure that the watchmen are alert and have the AVSST emergency number saved. Also, Auroville premises should remain accessible to all residents in case of such emergency.

CONFLICT RESOLUTION COUNCIL

Dear Community, as per our mandate, an important part of the Council's work is maintaining the harmony within the community. On a practical level this means very often supporting individuals and groups to deal with conflicts that couldn't be resolved between the parties themselves. The landscape of conflict resolution in Auroville has changed a lot in the last year with Koodam and Restorative Auroville not being part of the support system anymore. Partly the work is held by the Arbitration Coordination team in cases of appeals and arbitration and a valuable service and support is also offered by the Facilitators and Mediators Coordination team. Resources such as Mattram and also some individuals who serve as support persons are there to help the community to deal with conflicts today.

The Council aims at setting up a new structure that can hold conflict cases of all nature, as per Conflict Resolution Policy and make sure that the quality, in which this support is offered, remains as high as possible.

Therefore we decided to build a new team, the Conflict Resolution Council (CRC) under the Auroville Council's purview, consisting of 3-4 Council members as well as coordinators/administrators and additional team members who hold special skills to deal with conflict cases, to name a few such as psychological or social work background and mediation and facilitation skills. The team will also work closely together with all existing support structures and resources within the community (see graphic below).




Table 1: CRC in Auroville's landscape of Conflict Resolution (2022)

The CRC meets two to three times a week to consult on cases, decide on appropriate ways forward, find supporters for each case and follow up on building more resources in the community. Besides regular information and communication towards the community we are aiming at sharing educational resources for individuals and groups to better deal with conflicts early on and to avoid the escalation that we often observe.

The resolution of conflicts in Auroville should aspire for restorative approaches to re-establish relations and further enable reconciliation between concerned parties. We want to explore and hope to find ways towards a restorative justice in Auroville in which rule violations and misbehaviour amongst the community are met with cooperative and constructive measures rather than a call for an authority to step in and decide what is right and what is wrong.

We started working in this new structure and will soon reach out to you with an open call for members of the community with specific skills and experiences needed in this new team. In the meantime we would also like to invite you to offer your feedback on the topic of conflict resolution in Auroville and share your ideas and needs with us.

OUTCOME OF THE EMERGENCY RAD

to approve the Resolution of the Residents' Assembly
No. RAD/04/2022



Dear Residents, here are the results of the Emergency RAD (voting), called by the Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly, on the following Resolution. The summary of the topic of this Resolution is as follows:

"We, members of the Residents' Assembly of the Auroville Foundation, agree to pass a resolution that states that we, as one of the authorities of the Auroville Foundation as affirmed by the honorable Madras High Court, confirm that orders (Office Orders, Standing Orders and any other form of orders) from the Office of the Secretary and her appointees are not the result of a collaborative work with the RA, and have been issued without consultation with or approval by the Residents' Assembly, and affirm our support for the groups and appointees by the RA".

- A total of 1161 valid votes have been submitted online and in-person. The number of participants exceeded the 10% quorum required to validate the decision (239 votes)¹.


¹ Based on data received from the Residents Service, the total adult population of our community eligible to participate in RADs (age—above 18, confirmed Aurovilians) is 2386 (as of the month of August 2022).

Kindly note that as per [the RAD policy](#) "Only confirmed Aurovilians can participate in decision-making.

Those who have been announced as confirmed Aurovilians by the Entry Board are eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes **along with those** who have been entered into the Register of Residents maintained by the Secretary's Office. It does not include under 18-year-olds, newcomers and any other Auroville statuses".

This utterance is based on the WCom unanimously signed declaration that "the final decision of who is accepted as 'Aurovilian' should stay with the Residents' Assembly and not with the Secretary of the Auroville Foundation. Therefore, we have written to: the Residents' Assembly Service that those who have been announced as Confirmed Aurovilian by the Entry Board are eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes along with those who have been entered into the Register of Residents maintained by the Secretary's Office..." Residents' Assembly Decision:



97% (1122) participants voted in favour of the above Resolution.

1% (10) participants rejected it.

2% (29) participants abstained.

For your information: as the Residents' Assembly Service's Auroville email account has been blocked, we could not reach out to the community members via our regular mass email communication, and, consequently, many residents (especially those with their auroville.org.in email addresses) were not able to get the voting link on time. Despite all the difficulties this Emergency RAD was attended by an unprecedented number of participants.

We would like to remind you that, according to the [Provisional RAD Policy](#), "8. Responsibility for implementing decisions made through this RAD process lies with the concerned working group/s or resident/s".

NOTE: The Newcomer probation year becomes effective only after the NC kit has been returned and should not exceed 18 months from the date of confirmation.

A Newcomer becomes an Aurovilian once his/her name has been confirmed by The Admission Committee (aka the Entry Board) after following due process.

The date of becoming Aurovilian is the date of confirmation. An Aurovilian confirmed by the Entry Board is eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes.

A confirmed Aurovilian becomes officially a Resident of Auroville once the individual has filled in and signed the B-Form and his/her name has been entered in the Register of Residents (RoR) maintained by the Auroville Foundation Office (AVF).

A Resident of Auroville is eligible to become an executive of a Unit or Service of Auroville and to get an ID card issued by the Auroville Foundation.

A meeting with the Secretary of the AVF will be arranged by the Entry Secretariat according to the availability of the Secretary and not at any personal request.



MESSAGE TO MY AUROVILLE FRIENDS FROM ALL HORIZONS



Dear Aurovilians Friends, Auroville is a jewel, destined to be the model town for humanity. This jewel, today fractured by division, is in a weak position, threatened and coveted by external forces and interests. Where can Auro-

vilians look for protection? Only within themselves, not through any external recourse.

All Aurovilians, directly or invisibly, have been chosen by Mother, and nothing happens against Her will. Each one of them has its importance, and holds the capacity to overcome the trials encountered on the way. The critical point that you have now reached has arrived because this is the task that has been assigned to you.

How to restore harmony and unity among Aurovilians? For many, this is "Mission Impossible", or a matter of wishful thinking, but it is the only possible way to overcome the present impasse. This is not the first crisis that Auroville has managed to go through.

Already in the early days, Mother urged the pioneers to talk to each other, to get along, to come to an agreement. Both sides must first temper their extreme branches, rely on goodwill by rallying the moderates, who form the vast majority of the Aurovilian population, and then meet and commit themselves all together to the Middle Way.

In order to rebuild bridges, each must make an effort to consider the other's point of view. Some need to understand the frustration of the "builders", who have often been caught up in slow decision-making and bureaucratic hurdles, and acknowledge their desire to move forward in building the city.

Others need to break out of any prefabricated rhetoric, abandon authoritarian and arbitrary methods of governance that have already proven to be failing in human history, recognize the validity of a truly inclusive Residents' Assembly, and reintegrate it while ensuring that they are welcome to do so.

Auroville will happen, Mother's presence is there, it is palpable, and the city already exists in the subtle. Confidence must be renewed and the joyful sense of adventure rekindled. But this great change cannot be accomplished as long as the individual and collective consciousness remains at the vital-mental level alone.

Only through psychic awareness can we recognize and experience the profound unity of all, and feel the gratitude that connects us directly to Mother consciousness. May the whole consciousness of the Aurovilians, through active surrender to Mother's will and love, discover and overcome a kind of a pivotal point, where the impossible becomes possible.



Even on the most sublime planes of existence one fails to find the Power which would make life on earth divine. With a calm mind and detached heart, Aswapati turns his gaze away from the visible aspect of Nature towards the invisible vastnesses of the infinity from which our universe was born. *The Descent into Night* enables him to see the evil lurking at the root of Life. He becomes aware of the hidden Power which seems to be giving birth to the world and at the same time destroying it.

The obscure heart of Night is a spiritless Infinity, denying Truth and wanting to abolish God. There is no Light, no divine Soul there. Carefully guarding the flame of his divine Spirit, Aswapati unlocks the last door of the subconscious where he finds the secret key to the transformation of Nature. Hell dissolves. Soul lights up the conscious body; Matter and Spirit mingle and become one.

Immediately Aswapati's being is projected into *The Paradise of the Life-Gods*. Immersed in Light, perpetually divine, free from all adverse circumstances, that world lives in a jewel-rhythm of the laughter of God and universal love. At last, he finds calm and heavenly rest and his wounds are healed by the embraces of the divine Energies of pure bliss. The delights of this Life-Paradise cannot detain Aswapati's soul for long. Above him he discerns the large lucent realms of Mind.

But first he enters the twilight tract of dim and shifting rays from which he escapes into the realm of early Light. That realm, described in *The Kingdoms and Godheads of the Little Mind*, is served by a three-bodied trinity: the Physical Mind, a pygmy thought, needing to live in bounds, forever stooping to hammer fact and form; the Vital Mind, a rash Intelligence and an energetic and enthusiastic power without calm reflection; the Reason, the strongest and wisest of the three, who uses her lens and measuring rod, trying to understand the objective universe around her. But the little Mind is tied to little things and cannot reveal higher Truths. Aswapati goes beyond the limits of human Mind and enters the realms of *The Kingdoms and Godheads of the Greater Mind* with their immortal air. Here he can drink again from his pure and mighty source. From here he can see the giant stairs of thought climbing up to the heights where the last peaks of Time touch eternity's skies and Nature speaks to the Spirit's absolute.

The Ideal that Aswapati is seeking beckons him higher towards *The Heavens of the Ideal*. Each step he takes reveals a new luminous world and each stage of the soul's ascent takes the form of a permanent heaven, a rung in the mighty stairway of Existence. He is able to move freely through all these kingdoms of the Ideal. He accepts their beauty and greatness, but does not remain in any of them, for each one presents only a partial light of the ultimate Truth. Beyond are realms where those absolutes meet but none is willing to sacrifice its separate identity in order to find its own soul in the world's single soul.

Thus, he passes into the higher divine sphere where the radiant children of Eternity dwell in the immutable and inviolate Truth, forever united on the wide spiritual heights where all are one. That is the goal he is aiming at.

Then, entering In the *Self of Mind*, Aswapati finds himself alone. He feels that he can remain forever in this ultimate Self and ultimate Silence. His soul is at peace, it knows and is one with the cosmic whole.

But following a mysterious sound and a secret call, he enters into the realm of *The World-Soul*. This is the source of all finite life. Here all is soul or made of sheer soul-stuff. There is revealed to him the sole omnipotent Goddess, the Supreme Mother. As soon as he glimpses her, his spirit is turned into a vessel of her force. He is overwhelmed with Bliss; his soul emits a cry of adoration and surrender as he falls unconscious at her feet.

On the last step to the supernal birth, in *The Kingdoms of the Greater Knowledge* Aswapati walks along the narrow edge of extinction thrilled with the presence of the Ineffable. He is able to scan the secrets of the Overmind and bear the rapture of the Oversoul. Living on the borders of the Supramental Empire of the Sun, he links creation to the Eternal's sphere:

A Panegy that harmonised all life / Held now existence in its vast control; / A portion of that majesty he was made. (p.300)

Aswapati's will takes up the reins of cosmic Force. He has reached the summit of *The World- Stair*. *The Book of the Traveller of the Worlds*, describes the journey of Aswapati from the base of Matter to the unknowable summits of the Spirit and reflects Sri Aurobindo's own experiences and spiritual labours.

A meditative film of passages from Sri Aurobindo's epic poem *SAVITRI—A Legend and a Symbol*, read by the Mother, accompanied by Her own organ music and illustrated with paintings by Huta created under the guidance and with the inspiration of the Mother.

You should hold your baby naturally so it will create shadow from the side of you. And a smile needs to be there.





'ARUVADAI': INTERVIEW OF ANSHUL



In this issue, the Green Column team is welcoming 'Aruvadai' with their interview of Anshul. 'Aruvadai', consisting of Allan, Avinash, Isabelle, Madhuri and Nidhin, is offering support to the food sector, focusing on coordinating the needs and supply within Auroville to overcome challenges of competition and to support a more sustainable and self-sustaining food system.

In Conversation with Anshul, AuroOrchard.

Anshul first came to Auroville in 2014 as scientist and teacher. Soon, he turned to farming to seek a deeper understanding of the ecological, social and spiritual paradigms. He has a background in soil microbiology and permaculture design and has been working at AuroOrchard since 2019. Madhuri, long term volunteer at Annapurna is leading the interview.

Warm and dry long summer, what do you observe within the AuroOrchard landscape this year?

This year, summer seemed to be longer and drier. As we irrigate all our vegetable crops, water is not the limiting factor. But some of our crops like cucumbers, bottle gourds, pumpkins, don't do very well under prolonged intense sun. This summer also brought a lot of diseases and insect infestations. It is normal to have these throughout the year, but overall I felt there was more pressure from nature to not have so much food growing in the hot season. Naturally, summers in

this region would be a time for rest (like trees developing deciduous nature to prevent transpiration), so it was like nature telling us to slow down.

This year our fruit production was also lesser than the previous year. This may not be because of the summer itself but because of the normal cycle of the trees, as last year the harvests were bountiful.

What are the crops you are looking at harvesting closer to the arrival of monsoon and further till December?

As the sun starts moving southwards and the intensity of the heat reduces (starting from mid July, Aadi month of the Tamil calendar), we begin planting crops like basil, arugula, winged beans, jicama, sweet corn and greens like basella and some local spinach. This along with year-round crops like brinjal, ladies fingers, beans, cucumber, lauki, pumpkin and tapioca will make up for the monsoon harvest.

Could you take us through what goes into planning the coming season; are there any interesting crops or techniques being used?

It is very important to prepare our soil for the monsoon. The soil should be covered so that the rains don't compact it too much. We do this by sowing ground cover crops like Horsegram in fields and by adding a thick layer of mulch on the raised beds. The cover crops also help to control weeds, which intensify during monsoon due to the excess availability of water.

We also start sowing sunhemp on the raised beds in summer as less beds are in use. Starting July, the sunhemp starts flowering, at which point we cut it at the base and use the plant biomass to cover the soil. This way, we grow the mulch for the bed during summer/late summer to help keep it covered during monsoon months.

Some crops, especially greens and herbs, which can only do well post-summer also suffer during monsoon as they don't like excess moisture on their leaves. To avoid this, we plant these crops in a greenhouse. We also prepare saplings of papayas, lemongrass and other plants which can be planted during monsoon. Monsoon is also a good time to make cuttings and propagate plants like gliricidia, mexican sunflower, etc. which we use extensively to produce biomass for our raised beds.

Could you give us an economic overview for the growing season, with regards to vegetable cultivation?

About 80% of our cost of production for vegetables and fruits is labor expenses.

Auroorchard has a permanent workforce of 12 people who work on the preparation of the fields, planting and harvesting. This team is supported by Aurovilians and volunteers (which vary in number from one week to the next). So, changing seasons don't affect our cost inputs, labour-wise.

Of course, we spend much less on diesel during monsoon as there is no plowing or brush cutting which is a considerable cost, but there are also more repairs and maintenance post monsoon, so overall it is balanced. Any extra income from high value crops like basil and arugula is compensated by lack of income from fruits which make up most of our income during summer.

What are the challenges the farm is preparing for during monsoon season? What possibly do you think would interrupt the flow or planning of cultivation and harvest?

- Major challenges and what we do about it:
- Compaction of soil due to rain: add ground cover.
- Stagnant water on fields: plant on ridges or prepare raised beds.
- Excess moisture damaging certain crops: fix greenhouses and prepare the beds to receive the crops.
- Getting water to flow to and collect where required: prepare/repair channels and pits after first few rains.

Every year is different. Monsoon is a challenging time due to difficulty in working outside and the lack of sun which also hampers growth of plants.

I cannot think of anything that will interrupt our work extraordinarily, we continue to grow what we can.

What's your personal pick from the harvest and how would you like to have it?

I really enjoy having basil and arugula which we make into a pesto at home!



REGARDING TXUMA AND ELODIE'S HOUSE IN CENTER FIELD:

On the 31 July 2021 a walk of the Crown was organised. During this walk we were all of a sudden called names such as "Encroachers" and were told that Tapas/Mita's house would be demolished as well as our bathroom.

We had many meetings with the ATDC appointed at that time. During these meetings with members of the then ATDC (Toby, Ambu, Vidhya), we were assured that we could stay in our house and only the bathroom, and infrastructure needed to be moved.

Our last meeting with that same ATDC, including Toby, Rajendaran, Govind and Naren (AVFO) it was again agreed that the following would be done and funded, a new bathroom be built, shifting the existing Infrastructure (that we shared previously with Tapas and Mita), shifting the existing fence and even giving us a new NOC.

The work was supposed to start within a couple of days... But then the terrible events of Youth Center and Darkali happened and we didn't hear more from ATDC.

After feeling extremely threatened by some members of the community, Tapas and Mita moved out, as they were offered an alternative and Tapas was in no state of health to be able to deal with all that stress, after having just suffered some health issues.

It was after some months that on the 2nd may (my birthday) that all of a sudden, we heard a JCB arrive, without any kind of notice or warning, followed by a few people. They then proceeded to violently demolish Tapas and Mita's house, without any care of securing the area. They kept going for a few hours through the night. Then agreed to stop and came back the next day to demolish more of the house.

We were then also told that we needed to find the funds ourselves to do the shifts needed for our bathroom.

The Housing board offered to help us then.

Few days later we had a visit from Ambu and Sindhuja (newly appointed without the approval of the RA) to check about where the bathroom could be shifted to. They then asked us to get Estimates and drawings ASAP. We provided those within a few days.

We were then told that we would only get a temporary NOC of approx. 2 years for the bathroom and that it would only be for a minimal size, not as the existing one, and that we would need to fund it ourselves. We were also told that due to the NGT stay we were actually not allowed to build, so we would have to wait until the case was lifted Or find adequate, alternative housing immediately.

We then looked for alternatives but were not able to find or place to build or move in.

Sometime after, we received a letter in the afternoon from ATDC saying they would be coming the next day to demolish the bathroom.

We immediately contacted our working groups to ask for help and guidance. It was then that it was brought to Court.

We would like to add that in 1997 when we got this permission to build, the Crown Road was measured from a diameter of 710 mtrs taking the Banyan Tree as the centre. At that time our house or bathroom was not on the Crown, this only changed a few years ago, when the diameter was changed to 690 meters, thus changing the location of the Crown.

Present situation:

We have been living under extreme stress and incertitude since then, affecting us in many ways.

We would like to again bring to everyone's notice that we never blocked the development, we have only been asking for a just and honest process without violence and intimidation.

We are hoping the community can help us to find a peaceful way to move forward economically as well as harmoniously to shift the existing Infrastructure (Electricity, water and Internet connection), as well as build a new bathroom. Before the existing bathroom is dismantled.

We will again ask for a NOC for these shifts, and the time to make the shifts before the demolition of the existing bathroom and infrastructure happens. Hopefully this can happen without more violence and intimidation, but in a more respectful manner.


