


FAMC REPORT FOR AUGUST 2022.

- The BCC group has been restructured, as the former BCC had been reluctant to collaborate with us. The last straw was the creation of an alternative email address by them despite repeated requests from the FAMC to all working groups to refrain from doing so. The former BCC have changed their group access email.
- Forest group has refused to collaborate with us. In fact they have responded that they don't recognise this FAMC. So far we have requested a meeting with them twice. They have changed their group access emails.
- We have been extending a welcome to all the existing subgroups of FAMC to work together for the new direction of transparency, accountability and responsibility to execute on a jointly defined work plan that takes the growth and progress of their respective area in the larger context of Auroville's Funds & Assets Management.
- Shandra and Quentin from Sve Dame, whose house was in the red assets list of ATDC, have been permitted to shift to Sukhavati. FAMC along with ATDC is looking to form a policy for all the buildings on the red assets list.
- Farms sector review is undergoing.
- FAMC is setting up a pilot project with Gratitude Farms for setting up sustainable, organic food production for Auroville farm assets. This project will showcase a pathway to bring more of the farm assets of Auroville into sustainable productive use for the community food needs.
- It has come to our notice that there is a longstanding conflict in Buddha Garden. FAMC is encouraging both the parties to resolve it amicably in a given timeframe.
- Ramalingam of Sustenance Farm has requested some support regarding a Community Farming and Agricultural Training Project. FAMC is working with him to get more clarity.
- The FAMC team has met two groups interested in reopening the ACUR canteen and the decision regarding the same will be taken soon.
- It has been pointed out that all Aurovilians holding non Indian passports need to have a PAN card. FAMC is setting up a service to help with this. Those who already have a PAN card, should share the same with Foundation Office or FAMC. We will announce further steps for others who need to obtain the PAN card.
- Two members of the FAMC team and our resource person along with some members of ATDC, the Working Committee and the Secretary Dr. Jayanti Ravi visited the Raj Bhavan, Chennai for a function celebrating Sri Aurobindo's 150th anniversary.
- The thrust of FAMC is to move forward on compliance, accountability and transparency in all areas. Without cooperation, all new and ongoing work cannot progress with harmony and work stalls for Auroville as a whole. We urge all subgroups of FAMC to prepare their work plans and together we can review, coordinate and take forward necessary changes.
- As is evident, FAMC has a huge amount of work to do. We need collaboration from the community and we ask all people with skills in management and accounting, as well as people with goodwill and willingness to work, to contact us. All are welcome.

INVITATION TO RAGH ANANTHANARAYANAN

Dear Residents of Auroville, over the past many months, the IAC has received much input from residents regarding the current situation in Auroville. Although we have not responded directly to those sending letters and emails, we have been concerned and have been exploring ways to be helpful. During the last meeting of the GB and IAC in August, the Honorable R. N. Ravi, GB Chair, asked that we submit recommendations for ways to help ease the current challenges.



One recommendation was to invite **Raghu Ananthanarayanan** to help foster a dialogue that will hopefully help address some of the core issues dividing the community, a dialogue that an outside, neutral voice can best foster. Auroville is well known to Raghu. Although he has not been involved in the operations and functioning of Auroville, he knows the history and is deeply committed to the vision of Sri Aurobindo and the Mother, and the ideals of Auroville, ideals that have great relevance for the whole human community. He knows that what happens here will affect the wider world.

The Governing Board has approved this recommendation and he will soon begin reaching out to many of you to hear your perspective and get a fuller understanding of the issues at stake. Please feel free to express your views openly, and let us hope that a sense of unity, despite differences, will prevail.

This form is an open invitation to all residents of Auroville to share their reflections with Raghu and also nominate themselves or other resident(s) of Auroville to join the support team and/or speak with Raghu, which can happen either one-to-one or in a group, depending on how many more residents would like to speak with him over a video call sometime between September 15 and 20.

I've already received a wide range of responses, questions, suggestions, doubts, appreciation, criticism, feedback, gratitude etc for taking this work up. Dear Community, Auroville, as a collective experiment, needs our continuous efforts to improve its organization / structure / governance. Even in these challenging times, we have the responsibility to empower ourselves and realign our collective with the ideals of Auroville, within the current legal frame.

This is an open call to all residents motivated to join efforts. This might involve:

- Review and analysis of the current functioning and structures
- Collection and review of old and new proposals
- Translate ideas into concrete improvements, alternatives
- Review proposals, merge them (for instance like in the Dream Weaving process), establish constructive plans and strategies for making these changes concrete

NOTE: The Newcomer probation year becomes effective only after the NC kit has been returned and should not exceed 18 months from the date of confirmation.

A Newcomer becomes an Aurovilian once his/her name has been confirmed by The Admission Committee (aka the Entry Board) after following due process.

The date of becoming Aurovilian is the date of confirmation. An Aurovilian confirmed by the Entry Board is eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes.

A confirmed Aurovilian becomes officially a Resident of Auroville once the individual has filled in and signed the B-Form and his/her name has been entered in the Register of Residents (RoR) maintained by the Auroville Foundation Office (AVF).

A Resident of Auroville is eligible to become an executive of a Unit or Service of Auroville and to get an ID card issued by the Auroville Foundation.

A meeting with the Secretary of the AVF will be arranged by the Entry Secretariat according to the availability of the Secretary and not at any personal request.

FROM THE WORKING COMMITTEE

of the Residents' Assembly of the Auroville Foundation

Dear Community, the Working Groups selected by the Residents' Assembly have over the past months been doing their utmost to protect the rights and the role of the Residents' Assembly as a body of the Auroville Foundation. The Residents' Assembly as our legal container within the Auroville Foundation, graciously granted to us by Mother India, will give us, the people of all nations assembled for the Dream, the opportunity to live and realize the Charter of Auroville and to fulfill the purpose for which Auroville was created, that of Human Unity.

Over the past almost one year there have been many attempts by RA selected working groups and other members of the RA at mediation, collaboration and real dialogue, in order to synthesize diverse points of view and proposals. Although these attempts have not been successful, we feel that the possibility of facilitated dialogue or mediated discussions towards real solutions that reflect the spirit of Auroville should remain open, and would honor Auroville's aim to become a living embodiment of an actual human unity.

However, this cannot be done in the current atmosphere of oppression and at the cost of the autonomy, diversity or the safety of Auroville residents—it can only happen if the concerned parties stand on an equal, and respectful footing. We feel that dialogue or mediated discussions with an external and neutral party would be possible provided certain conditions were first met. These could include a commitment in writing that all methods of coercion, harassment and intimidation by the Office of the Secretary, Auroville Foundation are stopped; that the Residents' Assembly and its decisions regarding its internal functioning will be respected by all; and that until such mediated discussions have reached an outcome there will be no more physical destruction (ie roads, forests & parks, houses) or threats on visas and maintenances.

At the recommendation of Dena Mirriam, Chairperson of International Advisory Council, the Governing Board and Secretary, Auroville Foundation have invited Mr. Raghu Ananthanarayanan to 'help address some of the core issues dividing the community' and with the purpose 'enabling the stakeholders of Auroville to arrive at a consensus and commit to a way forward'. We have written to both Dena Mirriam and Mr. Raghu Ananthanarayanan to express deep concerns about the inappropriateness of both of these stated aims. It has been pointed out that the communication from Dena Merriam does not acknowledge that the core issue is the ongoing hostile environment created by the Secretary, seemingly with no objection from the Governing Board. We will be arranging meetings in which updates will be given by the legitimate Working Groups and to get input from the residents about the conditions that they feel need to be secured before engaging in any mediation or reconciliation process.

The date, time and place will be announced very soon.

PUBLICATION FIRST AID CAMPAIGN BY YOUTHLINK



The First Aid Awareness Campaign by YouthLink, in collaboration with Auroville Safety and Security Team, was carried out on the 5th of August in the Solar Kitchen corridor. The objective of this campaign was to raise awareness on the importance of quick emergency response,

the possible lack of trained members of the general public in our community, and to disseminate easily digestible information on how to preserve life in emergency situations.

Raising awareness



We showcased statistics regarding Cardiac Arrest and First aid response, emergency numbers, and the relationship between the three main organs which support life in our body. They were presented as infographic posters along with DR'S ABCD posters.

DR'S ABCD is a mnemonic used to memorise the step by step procedure to follow when encountering a victim of a serious injury/unconsciousness. They were also printed as handout flyers, which were distributed along with auroville emergency numbers cards and stickers.

Survey

An on-site survey was conducted, with the intention of recognising what people's experiences are in regards to emergency situations. The survey was divided into three categories:

- I have been in said situation
- I have seen said situation
- I have helped in said situation
- 70 people participated in our survey, out of which 13 people reported to have received first aid training.

240 votes were made on the onsite survey:

- 129 been in
- 52 seen
- 59 helped in




Wounds, burns, and dog bites were situations which were most prevalent, followed by fractures and severe bleeding. We suspect that people may not have understood the difference between wounds and severe bleeding.

Wounds and burns were also situations that most people have helped in, which correlates with the previous figures.

Interestingly, less people have confirmed to have been in the following situations than to have helped/ seen: Seizure, heart attack, hypoglycemia, CPR, stroke and unresponsive victim. This may be because they are all situations that have a higher mortality rate.

We also had a sign up sheet for a request for first aid training, to see if people were interested in receiving first aid training.



Action plan

We received 20 individuals who were interested in receiving training for first aid as well as three organisations (Svaram, Transition school, Thamarai), and we are looking for a way to provide for the demand.

During the Youth Day event on the 12th of Aug 2022, we had Philippe, Volunteer with the Auroville Safety and Security Team, conduct two one-hour workshops on First Aid, as the first part of the action phase of our Awareness Campaign. We hope to make first aid training more accessible and more recognised as a need in the future.



The awareness campaign got a lot of traction and involvement from the community, and we hope that this was a small first step for our community to become more safety conscious and that we will be able to offer a proper first aid course very soon.

We hope that one day every member of the community will be adequately trained in first aid so that we will be able to respond quickly and effectively to emergency situations.

As a Traveler of the Worlds Aswapati explored all the planes of existence and reached the summit of the World-Stair, but he had not yet found what he was looking for in order to establish the Life Divine upon this earth. He had a glimpse of the Supreme Mother and surrendered to her, but now the world appears empty to him. All knowledge seems to end in the Unknowable.

As the soul moves close to its self-discovery, there comes an absolute stillness; all that the Mind has known seems unreal. And behind the apparent zero Aswapati perceives the face of the immortal being and Presence. He sees a being of Wisdom, Power and Delight embracing Nature, World and Soul. From this Being a golden beautiful lustre flows into Aswapati's heart, touching through him all sentient beings.

This is the Mother of All, the mediatrix between Earth and the Supreme. All opposites prepare her supreme harmony. She, the Supreme Divine Mother stands at the head of Time, she is the bright heart of the Unknowable. All Nature calls to her alone to heal with her touch all the pain and longing of life and to kindle true aspiration in human hearts. Through her, all our separate selves will become one. She is the way and the goal.

Her rapture fills the limbs of Aswapati. All his quests are fulfilled in Her. But his freedom alone cannot satisfy him. He seeks her light and bliss for the whole earth and all humanity.

He knows that only the Light and Bliss of the Supreme Mother can bring about the Divine Life on Earth and he is calling out to her. Suddenly a mystic form embraces Aswapati's earthly body, and a boundless heart comes near his heart. The One whom he has adored and worshiped enters into him. She tells him:

"O Son of Strength who climbst creation's peaks.../ Alone thou standest at the eternal doors.../ What thou hast won is thine, but ask no more.../ Man is too weak to bear the Infinite's weight." (p.335)


But Aswapati's heart replies to her: "How shall I rest content with mortal days.../ And the dull measure of terrestrial things, / I who have seen behind the cosmic mask / The glory and the beauty of thy face?.../ I know that thy creation cannot fail.../ I saw the Omnipotent's flaming pioneers / Over the heavenly verge which turns towards life / Come crowding down the amber stairs of birth; / Forerunners of a divine multitude, / Out of the paths of the morning star they came / Into the little room of mortal life." (p.341, 342, 343)

Aswapati prays to the Divine Mother to incarnate with her Force and to send a living form of herself to earth. The Supreme Divine Mother finally agrees: *"O strong forerunner, I have heard thy cry. / One shall descend and break the iron Law, / Change Nature's doom by the lone spirit's power..." (p.348)* With the Divine Mother's agreement Aswapati's soul journeys back to earth and confronts the vast business of created things.



HELP TO RENOVATE MY HOUSE

I am Raja Narayanasamy, born and raised in Utility Community and studied in the bioregions of Auroville. My Grandfather and Father worked with Mali who is the founder of the Utility Community.

I officially became an Aurovillian in 2009

My service in Auroville started from Repos beach on 26th Dec 2004 after the Tsunami. I supported the community as an intermediate between the Fishermen and Aurovillians. I struggled with the cyclones and other natural calamities. With the cyclone Thane and later on with the beach erosion the Repos community disappeared in the ocean. So I moved to Celebration community in Auroville.

I worked in an Art gallery, Dehashakthi, Guest houses, Guest service, Auroville Security Service, and now in Auroville Land board. Since 2004, I have been living in Auroville in a hut house. I am getting maintenance and I have no other source of income to maintain my house which is in a very bad condition. The last monsoon completely damaged the thatch roof and the water infiltration damaged the flooring.

Since 2004 I have been living in a very difficult condition in a house which is almost destroyed. And since one year I am married, my wife is expecting a baby, so the situation has become even more serious

I desperately need to completely renovate the house with a budget of Rs 8,50,000 (eight and a half lakh).

At present I have raised Rs 4,50,000, including a grant of 2,00,000 from the Housing Service.

Numerous communities in the Green Belt devoted their work to restoring the eroded earth and to planting forests: Pitchandikulam, Samriddhi, Fertile, Revelation, Hermitage, etc...

This work necessitated using iron mining bars to make holes in the laterite and to then plant highly-resistant species such as the "Work Tree" (*Acacia auriculiformis*). Dams and water retainers were built to capture the monsoon rains, as well as thorny fences to protect the saplings from the wandering herds of cows and goats.

In 1982, the Government of India, impressed by the work of the Aurovilians, granted considerable funds over a period of 5 years to plant trees and carry out a scientific study on the results, so they could be reproduced elsewhere in India.

Seeds of indigenous species that are typical of the Tropical Dry Evergreen Forest (TDEF) were gathered from the sacred groves.

This seed-collection work enabled saving these species, safeguarding them within Auroville, and then propagating them throughout India. An identical work has been carried out for the re-introduction of indigenous medicinal plants. By **Nadia Loury**.

THE RING OF BRODGAR

Photo exhibition at Aurelec Art gallery "The Ring of Brodgar" Stonecircle in Orkney, Scotland
 Open timing 8am to 5pm, September 2022

The Ring of Brodgar (or Brogar, or Ring o' Brodgar) is a Neolithic Henge and stone circle in Mainland, Orkney, Scotland. It is the only major henge and stone circle in Britain which is an almost perfect circle. Most henges do not contain stone circles; Brodgar is a striking exception, ranking with Avebury and Stonehenge among the greatest of such sites.



The ring of stones stands on a small Isthmus between the Lochs of Stenness and Harray. These are the northernmost examples of circle henges in Britain. Unlike similar structures such as Avebury, there are no obvious stones inside the circle, but since the interior of the circle has never been excavated by Archeologists, the possibility remains that wooden structures, for example, may have been present.

The site has resisted attempts at scientific dating and the monument's age remains uncertain. It is generally thought to have been erected between 2500 BC and 2000 BC, and was, therefore, the last of the great Neolithic monuments built on the Ness. A project called The Ring of Brodgar Excavation 2008 was undertaken in the summer of that year in an attempt to settle the age issue and help answer other questions about a site that remains relatively poorly understood. The results of the excavation are still preliminary.

The stone circle is 104 metres (341 ft) in diameter, and the third largest in the British Isles. The ring originally comprised up to 60 stones, of which only 27 remained standing at the end of the 20th century.

The tallest stones stand at the south and west of the ring, including the "Comet Stone" to the south-east. The stones are set within a circular ditch up to 3 metres (9.8 ft) deep, 9 metres (30 ft) wide and 380 metres (1,250 ft) in circumference that was carved out of the solid sandstone bedrock by the ancient residents.

The monuments at the heart of Neolithic Orkney and Skara Brae proclaim the triumphs of the human spirit in early ages and isolated places.

They were approximately contemporary with the mastabas of the archaic period of Egypt (first and second dynasties), the brick temples of Sumeria, and the first cities of the

Harappa culture in India, and a century or two earlier than the Golden Age of China. Unusually fine for their early date, and with a remarkably rich survival of evidence, these sites stand as a visible symbol of the achievements of early peoples away from the traditional centres of civilisation...

The Ring of Brodgar is the finest known truly circular late Neolithic or early Bronze Age stone ring and a later expression of the spirit which gave rise to Maeshowe, Stenness and Skara Brae.




