

The Supramental Consciousness

It is quite difficult to define the supramental consciousness in mental terms, for it is non-mental by definition, and it defies all our three-dimensional laws and perspectives. The word itself may mislead us, because it is not an epitome of human consciousness, but another type of consciousness. We might try to approach it by distinguishing two aspects, one of consciousness or vision, and one of power. But this means becoming caught in the mental trap again, because these two aspects are inseparable; this consciousness is power, an active vision. Often, when Sri Aurobindo and Mother tried to describe their experience, their remarks would echo one another in English and in French: Another language would be needed, *une autre langue*.

The Supramental Vision

The supramental vision is a global vision. The mind dissects little fragments and opposes them to one another. The overmind connects everything with a single beam, but its beam terminates in a single point, and it sees everything from its own particular point of view; it is unitary and universal either by way of excluding all other perspectives or else by annexing them. The Supramental, or Supermind, sees not only the whole of things and beings within a single vision, connecting all the beams together without opposing anything, but it also sees the point of view of each separate thing, each being, each force; it is an all-encompassing view that does not terminate in a single, central point but in myriads of points:

a single innumerable look...

The supramental being sees things not as one on the levels surrounded by a jungle of present facts and phenomena but from above, not from outside and judged by their surfaces, but from within and viewed from the truth of their centre. Therefore, we cannot understand anything about the Supramental if we do not constantly refer it to another dimension. But we can understand that it is the very vision of Wisdom, because each thing, each being, each force on the earth moves toward a special absolute, expressing it more or less accurately and often perversely, but despite all the flaws and perversions it obeys an intimate law that impels it towards the one truth of its being-even the leaves on the same tree are all unique. If it were not for that absolute and unique truth at the center of each one of us, we would crumble. This is also why we are so attached to our own smallness and stumblings, because we do sense the truth that is behind them, growing behind them, as if protected, Sri Aurobindo said, by that very smallness and all those stumblings. If we got hold of the whole truth at once, we would turn it into some gnome in our own present image! Truth has nothing to do with thought or good deeds, though these may be steps on the way; it has to do with a vastness of being. And the growth process is slow and difficult. Errors, falsehoods, stumblings! they cry. How bright and beautiful are Thy errors, O Lord! Thy falsehoods save Truth alive; by Thy stumblings the world is perfected. But the mind, which sees only the present surface of things, seeks to trim off all the rough edges, purify by exclusion, and reduce its world to a uniform, righteous and equitable truth. It decrees, "This is good, that is bad; this is friendly, that is hostile." It might want to eliminate all the Nazis from the world or all the Chinese, for instance, thinking they are quite unnecessary calamities. And the mind is right, by definition, since it is designed to be reasonable and since it, too, expresses a mental or moral absolute that has its place and purpose. But this is not the whole truth; it is only one point of view, as Sri Aurobindo called them, with a consciousness that is vision and power. Finally, this is why we lack power, for if we possessed power, we would, with the best of intentions, precipitate a catastrophe through ignorance or short-sightedness. Our shortcomings are necessary shortcomings. Not only does the supramental consciousness capture all the points of view, but also the deeper forces at work behind each thing as well as the truth within each thing: it is a Truth-Consciousness—and because it sees all, it automatically possesses Power. We are powerless because we do not see. To see, and to see totally, necessarily means to have power. But the supramental power does not obey our logic or morality; it sees far into space and time, and it does not try to do away with evil in order to save the good, nor does it work through miracles; it frees the good that is within the evil, applying its force and light on the dark half so it consents to its luminous counterpart. Wherever it is applied, the immediate effect is to touch off a crisis; that is, to place the shadow in front of its own light. It is a stupendous evolutionary ferment.

Jownhall Speaks

L'AVENIR D'AUROVILLE/ ATDC Application Announcement 06-04-2023

A. The following Building Applications have been received and approved (information only):

PROJECT NAME—Nithiya & Velmurugan BA—NO 2611

- Applicant/s: Nithiya & Velmurugan
- Location/area: Discipline / Green Belt
- Area for which approval is sought: 68.17 sq.m

Project brief: 1st floor was not built in compliance with the NOC provided to them on November 20, 2012. Nithiya applied with Housing Service for a stewardship agreement. At this point the background of the asset was requested by Housing Service, and L'avenir d'Auroville/ATDC agreed to regularize the asset and to issue the approval certificate in order for the Housing Service to give the stewardship agreement. However, a Completion Certificate needs to be obtained by Nithiya & Velmurugan (as will be the case for all assets in Auroville) as requested by L'avenir d'Auroville/ATDC, which will require further details to be furnished.

PROJECT NAME—Idoya—BAA—NO. 2580

- Applicant/s: Idoya Tobar
- Location/area: Maitreye / Residential Zone
- Area for which approval is sought: 74.72 sq.m

Project brief: Idoya would like to build an apartment—studio on the top of Monica's studio in Maitreye 1 to gain a residential space for herself. The studio is proposed on the first floor of an existing building, so this does not increase the footprint, and helps with densification.

PROJECT NAME—Aurorachana

Space-Hall—Phase 1—BAA—NO. 2590

- Applicant/s: Clemens Gruttmann
- Location/area: Hope / Outside Master Plan
- Area for which approval is sought: 206 sq.m

Project brief: Import and export facility in Hope is used for many years for many people and units in Auroville. The new hall will improve the storage facilities and movement of goods also in the future for the city. People are coming and going on a regular basis in Auroville and we are providing the logistic service for many of them.B. The following Building Application has been received and approved (feedback requested before the 20th of April 2023 to application-avenir@auroville.og.in):

PROJECT NAME—Jayamoorthi—BA—NO 2610

- Applicant/s: Jayamoorthi & Premalatha
- Location/area: La Ferme / Outside Master Plan
- Area for which approval is sought: 23.15 Sq.m

Project brief: Existing storeroom is in the condition of falling off & don't have parking to park the bikes.

C. The following project has received Preliminary Design Approval (feedback requested before 20 April 2023 to <u>application-avenir@auroville.og.in</u>):

PROJECT NAME—Morning Star Women Wellness— PDA—NO 2597

- Applicant/s: Paula Murphy
- Location/area: Crown / Residential Zone
- Area for which approval is sought: 457.07 Sq.m

Project brief: Currently there is no delineated space for birthing and women wellness in Auroville. Morning Star will be the first building in Auroville to focus on women wellness and childbirth. According to a survey taken in 2016, 41% of women felt Auroville is not a welcoming place for pregnant women.

Constructive feedback guidelines:

So far, while giving permissions, we have asked the project team to include approval from the neighbors. This has no resonance with the ideals of Auroville where we are supposed to be headed towards a life guided by no desire, no preferences and no sense of ownership. We will no longer request this approval.

Similarly when we publish projects for approval, we will discard all personal feedback with respect to "neighbors choosing neighbors" or "neighbors choosing development guidelines".

All other feedback is welcome and will be part of the process.

WORKING COMMITTEE REPORT January—February 2023

Joint Group Meeting to the Community

A presentation of work by the Working Committee, ATDC and FAMC to the Community was held on 10th January and had a good attendance. The presentation was live streamed and was followed by an hour long session of Q& A when a maximum of questions were taken up. Unfortunately the start of the meeting was marred by disruptions of a certain group who then staged a walk-out. One of the members forcibly snatched the attendance sheet on her way out. We request this person to kindly return the attendance sheet for our records.

G-20 visit of the delegates on 31.1.23

G20 delegates of various countries visited the International Township of Auroville in the morning of 31st January 2023. They were welcomed at the Visitors Centre, followed by visits to the Auroville City Exhibition at Bharat Nivas, Matrimandir, concluding at the Unity Pavilion with a presentation on Auroville.

The G-20 event was a great success and there was a good interaction with the delegates. We would like to thank the Secretary, Auroville Foundation, the Governing Board and the Government of India for putting Pondicherry and Auroville on the G20 map in connection with Sri Aurobindo's 150th year. It has generated interest, exposure of the Auroville experiment and possibilities of further collaborations.

Development: Crown

Storage

The surface slabs for the Crown road have arrived and the infrastructure channels for water, electricity, optical fibre etc are being installed.

Development: Solar Kitchen Parking

The new large parking space at the solar kitchen, created with the old crown pavers, is nearing completion and adds a new dimension to the multifunctional solar kitchen cum shopping complex.

Auroville Festival 23

The Birthday Week Festival started on 21.2.23 on Mother's Birthday. For one week, ending at Auroville's birthday on the 28th of February. This year's festival theme is Sincerity, the first quality of the Mother's symbol, every day from 7 am to 7 pm, with a morning meditation with the Om choir and an exploration of the 4 aspects of the Divine Mother as described by Sri Aurobindo through talks, panel discussions, music and diverse cultural performances and poetry and Tamil culture. There was a special focus on the city, each day, exploring different parts of the master plan spiritually and materially. Other events of note were the inauguration of the Mother's Flower Garden.

The Auroville Festival was organized by AWARE, a unit under Auroville Services Trust, which plans to organize the festival activities under this umbrella each year.

Visit of the German consul Mrs Michaela Küchler from Chennai on 6.2.23

Mrs Küchler was welcomed in Auroville by Dr Jayanti Ravi, Secretary of the Auroville Foundation, joined by 4 German Aurovilians. It was Mrs Küchler's first visit to Auroville and she had many questions regarding the aims and objectives of Auroville, and the city to be built. She also informed herself of the visa situation. She was particularly interested to hear about the present conflict in the community since some German Aurovilians had voiced their concerns and complaints to her. We explained the situation as best as we could and recommended the article.

We informed Mrs Küchler about the G-20 event, gave her the Auroville introduction and the International Zone and shared different aspects of the Volunteer programme.

Ambassador of Norway visit

Mr Hans Jacob Frydenlund, the Ambassador of Norway from New Delhi, visited Auroville on the 14th of February 2023 with his staff and a 30+ member strong delegation from the Ministry of Earth Sciences. The Ambassador and the delegates were shown an introductory Auroville video at the Visitors Center, followed by a visit to the Matrimandir and the Auroville model city exhibition in Bharat Nivas. In Savitri Bhavan the Ambassador was given a brief presentation on The Mother and

Sri Aurobindo and Auroville followed by a warm interchange and Q & A.

FIR filed by PKS

On 04.01.2023 one P.K. Subramani who encroached on about 8 acres of Auroville land in the greenbelt masterplan near ABRI corner/Evergreen situated next to the tar road, filed a FIR against Aurovilians. Unfortunately Land Board members and staff and a member of the Working Committee who had gone to check what was happening are also named in the FIR and we hope to rectify this. On the subject day none of the persons against whom the FIR is filed were present at the site of the property in Irumbai R.S. No. 426/1E. The allegations mentioned in the FIR are false and fabricated. The FIR needs to be quashed. A request has been made to the Auroville Foundation to get Anticipatory Bail and also to file a quash petition at Madras High Court. A legal case has been filed by the Auroville Foundation against PKS in regards to the land encroachment.

International Advisory Council (IAC) and meeting with city support group and the 3 working groups

On 17 February a group of Aurovilians and members from the 3 working groups met with 3 IAC members Dena Merriam, H.P. Rama, and Gabi Gillessen. The IAC members had met with Aurovilians at a 'Residents Assembly which only welcomed the closed members of a group and a large number of Aurovilians were unaware of it. An Aurovilian judged to be 'on the other side' was asked to leave and not allowed to attend. On following the You-Tube link after the meeting many residents reached out to the Working Committee to organize a meeting with the IAC given the misleading image presented and the complaints made against the Secretary the GB and GOI. The Working Committee then invited the IAC members who were still in Auroville to share a different perception of the events, answer their questions and provide them with facts. The gathering re-assured them with evidence and reasons regarding the Mother's city, facts about the Crown and that it has to be built according to the Galaxy plan worked out with Roger Anger, the chief architect. Many doubts regarding the actions of the Foundation could also be clarified and it was expressed that Auroville needs to get back to its objectives as a city and a society along the Mother's guidelines.

Mother's flower garden inaugurated in the Mahalakshmi Park (near Solar Kitchen)

A new beautiful flower project was inaugurated on Mother's Birthday 21-2-23. The project will plant and exhibit all the flowers which were given spiritual names by The Mother and bring an awareness of the unique spiritual qualities of flowers and their consciousness in Auroville's life and culture. Auroville International (AVI) not in a collaborative space

Auroville International members met in Auroville in February. They once again refused a joint call by the Working Committee to meet the 3 working groups to start a process of collaboration. We will need to find other means to communicate with them and a policy that will put the relationship of the AVI with Auroville on an unbiased, transparent and collaborative ground that assists Auroville in its growth and its unity. At present they seemed aligned with the group that continues to boycott or obstruct Auroville's development and other Aurovillars and actively campaign against the Secretary, Auroville Foundation and remain hostile to all those who support the development of the Crown.



INFORMATION RELATED TO SEXUAL HARASSMENT

Dear Community, as part of our ongoing effort to ensure safety in our community, we would like to share again important information about available support for situations related to sexual harassment in Auroville.

If someone feels they have experienced sexual harassment in some form and needs personal support and advice, they are encouraged to contact Maatram (<u>maatram@auroville.org.in</u>, +91 90877 09434). In addition, if anyone has concerns or suspects that sexual harassment has taken place they may approach the CRP3 team (<u>crp3.auroville@</u> <u>gmail.com</u>) for advice. (The CRP3 team consists of representatives from Maatram, AVSST, Auroville Council, Working Committee and resource persons and addresses situations of conflict that include violence of some kind, under Section 3 of the Auroville Conflict Resolution Policy).

There is an Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) that exists and is active in Auroville specifically to address complaints of sexual harassment towards any resident, volunteer, employee, etc. The ICC functions under the POSH Act and under an internal policy, according to the situation.

Please be aware that the ICC:

- will only start a process if and when a complaint is submitted directly to them either by the complainant or by a representative designated by the complainant. A process will not be initiated by the ICC on its own;
- is bound to absolute confidentiality throughout the process as per Section 16 of the POSH Act and Section 7 of the Internal Policy.)

We encourage everyone to please ensure that these sensitive situations are held within a process that aims at integrity, confidentiality and fairness towards all involved.

REFLECTIONS ON THE BCC

Dear Community, we are writing to share our reflections on the important socio-economic issues raised in the AVFO BCC—FAMC communication of April 2 and the AVFO BCC Interim Report of March 2023, as we have insight into these issues given our previous experience as BCC members.

We are concerned that these communications do not reflect a movement towards the ideals of Auroville, nor an attitude of care for the economic realities that people face at present. Instead, these communications are focussed on imposing rules and conditions. We do not feel that this approach can foster a new economy that embodies the spirit of Auroville. On the contrary, it is a move away from inspiring us all to contribute to the collective. We feel that the community trust and engagement that we built up in recent years is being undermined.

We are also concerned that the BCC work has been taken up by 3 individuals with no prior experience, and Tally. This is not in keeping with the BCC mandate, which calls for 11 members to ensure diversity and representation.

Some specific concerns we would like to raise from their recent communications are:

The decision not to increase the wages of Auroville employees: Even at the height of the Covid-19 lockdown, the then BCC and FAMC decided to increase wages as per government guidelines. This decision was based on solidarity with the bioregion and the important role local employees play in Auroville's economy.

The decision to restrict Maintenances: The Mother's founding vision for Auroville was a society in which individuals would participate (in work, kind or money) and whose basic needs would be taken care of by the collective. The current reality is that Auroville is not providing for the basic needs of all Aurovilians. The restrictions on Maintenances that are being imposed (such as not allowing individuals to work two jobs and be remunerated for both) only makes it harder for those with less financial means to be a part of this community. We do not see any solutions proposed to address this issue and arrive at the economy The Mother envisioned.

The approach to individual contributions: It is important to distinguish between a contribution and a tax. Previous BCC teams had a subgroup that managed the collecting and waiving of individual contributions, taking into account financial hardship and other forms of contribution. For example, contributions are waived because the individuals are working for free, or previously made large donations to Auroville (and are now aged), or are between jobs and without resources. The current approach seems to be to administer the individual contributions as a tax, without understanding or honouring this human element. In the past, we have noted that requesting individual contributions has resulted in increased requests for Maintenances (to pay the contribution!), therefore we do not believe that this approach will increase the income to City Services. Furthermore, the current proposal of transferring the individual contribution amount to individual accounts as a Maintenance 'surplus' that would be immediately transferred back to City Services would only inflate the Maintenance, while not representing an increased Maintenance or increased income to City Services.

Given the comments made on the lack of accounting / monitoring of expenses of previous BCC teams, we wish to communicate that our BCC team monitored the income and expenses of services receiving a CS budget on a monthly basis. We also had an accountant working with us and publishing detailed monthly reports of contributions and disbursements of the City Services fund. We have observed that the current AVFO BCC is not publishing financial reports as detailed as ours were.

SOME NOTES ON THE MINUTES OF THE 60[™] MEETING OF THE GOVERNING

Environmental Clearance for Auroville Universal Township

- The minutes mention the Board's approval to get the Environmental Clearance for Auroville Universal Township as per the National Green Tribunal judgment, under Item 8 (b) of the EIA Notification, 2006 with the support from ABC Techno Labs India Private Limited, Chennai at an estimated cost of Rs. 44/- lakh.
- We observe that the NGT Order of April 28, 2022, mentions that the Auroville Foundation " is directed to prepare a proper township plan either in respect of 778 Ha which is in their possession now or in respect of 1963 Ha which was visualized by the MOTHER by identifying the locations where each zone will have to be located, where the roads will have to be laid showing the location of the ring roads with their width and further road, if any, to be constructed, the nature of industries and other activities which they are expected to establish in the township and if it is not going to be implemented as one phase, how many phases in which they are going to complete the project and then apply for Environmental Clearance (EC) as it will fall under Item 8 (b) of the EIA Notification, 2006 as amended from time to time." (emphasis added).
- As the NGT directed that an application for Environmental Clearance has to be made of the township plan, the formulation of which is the prerogative of the Residents Assembly as per section 19.2.c of the Auroville Foundation Act, [The Residents' Assembly may formulate the master plan ... for the approval of the Governing Board], which has not yet been done, we do not understand why the Board, which has the right to prepare and effectuate the Township Plan as per section 17.e of the Auroville Foundation Act [The powers and functions of the Governing Board shall be to prepare a master-plan of Auroville in consultation with the Residents' Assembly and to ensure development of Auroville as so planned] is asking ABC Techno Labs to help get Environmental Clearance at this time.

Auroville Integrated Information System

- We would appreciate it if the community is informed about the status of the envisaged Auroville Integrated Information System (AIIS) to integrate all the units of Auroville.
- Some questions that have come up: Which Auroville residents are/will be involved in the collaboration with the IIIT Tiruchirappalli for the approved period of 2 years? Who is being commissioned to make this program and at what cost? Who will be managing the data and ensuring responsible handling of the data?

Auroville Smart City project

 In the interests of transparency, the community needs to be informed about the status of the Smart City proposal of AVF and Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (C-DAC), Bangalore, with the support from Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), and also informed about which Auroville residents are involved.

Regulations of Standing Order / ATDC

- We would appreciate it if the 'Regulations of Standing Order of January 2011' referenced in the minutes would be publicly accessible, e.g. by publication on the AVF website.
- The issue of whether the Board has acted within its powers to constitute the Auroville Town Development Council (ATDC) as per Standing Order dated 01-06-2022 is pending in court.

Organization and Governance Committee

- All the recommendations of the Organization and Governance Committee need to be shared with the Residents' Assembly as one of the statutory authorities of the Auroville Foundation.
- It is to be noted that there are a number of topics that have been taken up by the OGC and recommendations made by the Governing Board that have already been discussed at length within the Residents' Assembly over the years, with various actions taken and mechanisms put in place in an ever-evolving reality.

Proposal for construction of 1000 persons studio model flats

- The proposal for construction of a 1,000 persons' studio model flats needs to be shared with the Residents' Assembly and follow transparent processes as has been usual practice until recently.
- In accordance with section 19.2.a of the Auroville Foundation Act, it is the prerogative of the Residents' Assembly to allow the admission of persons in the register of residents ... in accordance with the regulations made under section 32. Given the slow population growth of Auroville, information is required about who would occupy these studio model flats, and on what conditions.
- We do not believe that the Board has the right to create a special category of people, whether 'honorary Aurovilians' or even 'volunteers', to join Auroville who would not be subject to the conditions for living in Auroville and whose names would not be entered into the Register of Residents.

THE SIGNIFICANCE OF 24 APRIL DARSHAN DAY The Mother's Final Arrival at Pondicherry



Monday, 17 April 2023, 4pm at Savitri Bhavan. Duration: 37min.



Dr Alok Pandey reflects upon Vedanta and Tantra, the best aspects of Western and Eastern culture and the unique relationship between the Mother and Sri Aurobindo. He discusses in detail the role and potential of the Purusha and the Shakti.

Sri Aurobindo as the Supreme Purusha is the witness self; in the Gita, it is the Purushottama. He stands and silently sanctions all that is happening, and yet he is unmoved.

Here, in this world, the Puru-

sha has so far been a diminished godhead, and the Purusha within—"not bigger than the thumb of man". But now it is going to change: the Purusha has to recover and discover its godhead, the Ishvara. The Purusha will go to the birthplace of the godhead and will discover its supramental godhead and supramental personality.

On the other hand, the Mother presents the Divine Shakti, the power that is going into the creation. She organizes all the processes and details of life and inspires the art of culture. So far, the Shakti has been acting through limited and divided consciousness. It is what we call nature or Prakriti, which mostly acts mechanically, is partly conscious and partly unconscious, and yet behind it stands perfect consciousness, which limits itself to the needs of each species. Prakriti is the diminished form of Mahashakti and also has to gain and regain her own glory and splendor. Nature in us is toiling and struggling in darkness and is yearning to return to its spiritual home and oneness, light, truth, bliss, sweetness, and love.

The evolutionary need to bring the Spirit and Nature together is impelling. And for this great work and realisation Sri Aurobindo and the Divine Mother have come together. During their meeting on 24 April 1920, on the Mother's final arrival to Pondicherry, both immediately felt that "now the realisation will be accomplished". The Mahashakti, the Mother, totally surrendered to Sri Aurobindo, and the Supreme Purusha, Sri Aurobindo, instructed and installed the Divine Mother as the guiding and moving force who would henceforth govern and direct our human race along the pathways that are intended and willed by the Divine.

The union of the two Avatars, Sri Aurobindo and the Mother, of Purusha and Shakti, was needed for the Supramental to descend on earth. And in the new evolutionary process, the Mahashakti sits on the right side of the Supreme Purusha and executes the will of the Divine.

The Foundation Act begins with a simple statement:

Whereas Auroville was founded by the 'Mother' on the 28th day of February, 1968 as an International Cultural Township;

It would seem some have a hard time with the word "International" and what this implies. While others, it would seem have a hard time with the word "Township". It should be noted that the 74th Constitutional Amendment Act of 1992 proposes establishing a uniform structure of Municipal Councils, and Nagar Panchayats. This Act allowed them to function as effective democratic units of local selfgovernment. One might think that this, in the context of Auroville, help define what a township means and the meaning of what it means to be a Citizen of Auroville.

Perhaps, it would seem, that some have a difficult time with the idea of "Auroville" itself.

It is interesting to note what the Auroville Foundation Act itself states concerning the relationship between our Governing body and the Citizens of Auroville;

The Powers of the Governing Board is to promote the ideals of Auroville and to coordinate activities and services of Auroville in consultation with the Residents' Assembly for the purposes of cohesion and integration of Auroville;

The purpose of cohesion is to form a united whole. In effect, Unity.

Intuitively we have arrived and gathered here to create a foundation that sits outside the reality of the distorting prism of bureaucracy and the domain of mental regulations. We have been asked to cross a bridge from something tired and old into a realm of vision, into a City of Revelation. Perhaps it is time to redefine who we are and what our intentions truly are.
