



House of Mother's Agenda



It is not just the body and the mind that will have to change with the supramental consciousness, but also life's very substance. If there is one sign that characterizes our mental civilization, it is the use of artifices. Nothing happens naturally; we are the prisoners of a thick web of substitutes: airplanes, telephones, televisions, and the plethora of instruments and devices that mask our impotence. We forget that our marvellous inventions are only the material extensions of powers that exist within us; if they were not already there, we would never have been able to invent them. We are that thaumaturge sceptic of miracles, Sri Aurobindo spoke of. Having delegated to machines the task of seeing for us, hearing for us, and travelling for us, we have now become helpless without them. Our human civilization, created for the joy of life, has become the slave of the means required for enjoying life: sixty percent of our lifetime is spent acquiring means and another thirty percent sleeping. What is absurd here, says the Mother, is all the artificial devices we must use. Any idiot has more power provided he has the means of acquiring the necessary devices. But in a true world, a supramental world, the more conscious and in harmony with the truth of things you are, the more your will has authority over substance; substance responds to the will. There, authority is a true authority. If you want a dress, you must have the power to make it, a true power. If you don't have that power, well, you go naked! There is no artifice to substitute for the lack of power. While here, not once in a million times is authority the expression of something true. Everything is colossally stupid. This supramental "authority" is not some kind of supermagic, far from it; it is an extremely precise process, as precise and exact as a chemistry experiment, except that instead of dealing with external objects, the supramental being acts upon the true vibration in the core of each thing and combines it with other vibrations in order to achieve a particular result, like a painter mixing colors for a picture or a poet combining sounds for a poem. He is truly a poet, for he creates what he names. The true name of an object is the vibration constituting it; to name an object is to have the power to evoke it or to destroy it.

The spontaneous and natural quality of supramental life for ultimately only Truth is natural—will be expressed also in a supramental art, which will be a direct and exact representation of our particular spiritual tonality; an art in which cheating will have become impossible because only our inner light will be able to touch and play upon the same lights involved in Matter and mold from it the corresponding forms. If our vibration is gray, our creation will be similarly gray, and everything we touch will be gray. Our physical, external environment will be the exact image of our inner environment; we will be able to manifest only what we are. Life itself will be a work of art, our outer dominion the changing stage of our inner states. Our language, likewise, will have power only through the true spiritual force within us; it will be a living mantra, a visible language like the play of emotions upon a human face. All shams will draw to an end, whether they be political, religious, literary, artistic, or emotional. Once, when a sceptical disciple commented that the Supermind was an impossible invention, first of all, because it had never been seen or realized before, Sri Aurobindo replied with his typical humor: What a wonderful

argument! Since it has not been done, it can't be done! At that rate the whole history of the earth must have stopped long before the protoplasm. When it was a mass of gases, no life had been born, ergo, life could not be born—when only life was there, mind was not born, so mind could not be born. Since mind is there but nothing beyond, as there is no Supermind manifested in anybody, so Supermind can never be born. Sobhanallah! Glory, Glory, Glory to the human reason! Luckily the Divine or the Cosmic Spirit or Nature or whatever is there cares a damn for the human reason. He or She or It does what He or She or It has to do, whether it can or can't be done. Thousands of years ago, the rishis had already spoken of the skeptics' misfortune: "In these there is not the Wonder and the Might." (Rig Veda VII.61.5)

The Work (First Phase)

As remarkable as the end result will be, the work of getting there is modest and humble and patient, exactly like the work of a scientist with his vials and test tubes: a microscopic work, says the Mother. For it is not a question of performing miracles, but of securing a new physical base by freeing the consciousness-force in each atom and each cell. One might think that this work on the body involves psychophysical methods similar to hatha-yoga, but it is nothing of the kind. Consciousness is and remains the main tool: The change of consciousness will be the chief factor, the initial movement, the physical modification will be a subordinate factor, a consequence. With his usual clarity, Sri Aurobindo puts us before the fact: In the previous stages of the evolution Nature's first care and effort had to be directed towards a change of consciousness; this was a necessity imposed by the insufficiency of the force of consciousness already in formation to effect a change in the body. But in man a reversal is possible, indeed inevitable; for it is through his consciousness, through its transmutation and no longer through a new bodily organism as a first instrumentation that the evolution can and must be effected. In the inner reality of things a change of consciousness was always a major fact, the evolution has always had a spiritual significance and the physical change was only instrumental; but this relation was concealed by the first abnormal balance of the two factors, the body of the external Inconscience outweighing and obscuring in importance the spiritual element, the conscious being. But once the balance has been righted, it is no longer the change of body that must precede the change of consciousness; the consciousness itself by its mutation will necessitate and operate whatever mutation is needed for the body.

GUIDELINES FOR AUROVILLE DONATIONS CHANNELING AND FUNDRAISING

To the Community. FAMC has formed a Donation Channeling Group (DCG) consisting of persons from the Financial Services, FAMC, Talam and Aware. The focus of the group is to outline a full cycle Donations Channeling process and tracking the need, intent and funds utilization across the various nodes along the spectrum of grant utilization. This setup is an outcome of the Systems & Processes audit completed by the Organization and Governance Committee of the Governing Board. Donations tracking across the full spectrum of its life cycle is required to be brought into purview. This allows for FCRA regulation reporting, provides for transparency and accountability to the donor organizations and finally provides for annual reports on all the support of funds, grants and goodwill towards Auroville from across the world. New donations and grants channels also are possible to approach once a comprehensive program is in operation.

Attached is the document outlining the Guidelines for Auroville Donations Channeling and Fundraising. Once the proper communication channel is set up for putting the donation channeling processes as per these guidelines, the DCG team will send out the instructions on how to use it and organize a few presentations for the community.

Auroville Foundation Funds and Assets Management Committee GUIDELINES FOR FUNDRAISING, 16 June 2023

1. Background and Context

- 1. Auroville has been conceived as a universal township for the manifestation of the Auroville ideals and vision as given by the Mother. Auroville Foundation has been established as an autonomous body under the Ministry of Education, Government of India by an Act of Parliament "for the purpose with a view to making long-term arrangements for the better management and further development of Auroville in accordance with its original charter and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto".
- 2. The development of Auroville as a township requires significant funding, of which a major part will come from donations, grants and contributions while the recurring expenditure of Auroville will increasingly be met from Auroville's own income-generating activities as part of the vision of Auroville being a self-supporting township
- 3. These guidelines have been prepared for the purpose of having transparent and effective processes relating to fundraising and the expenditure of funds raised.

2. Alignment with the Auroville vision

- 1. Projects for which fundraising is undertaken should align with the ideals and vision of Auroville.
- 2. Funds for Auroville township development shall be raised and spent only for development in accordance with the Auroville Master Plan as prepared and approved under section 17[e] of the Auroville Foundation Act.
- 3. Fundraising activities and documentation need to outline clearly how Auroville's development will benefit from the funds proposed to be raised.

3. Sustainability

 Project proposals must include a road map for the environmental, social and financial sustainability of these projects.

4. Reporting

1. Donors and grantors will need to be given regular updates on the impact of their contributions.

2. Auroville units, activities and projects that make use of donated funds should have a robust donor relationship program in place to ensure that donors and grantors are regularly informed about project progress.

5. Transparency

- 1. A high degree of trustworthiness and transparency shall be maintained in project operations, including financial management, governance, and impact reporting.
- **2**. Donors, grantors and other contributors must be able to see evidence of their contributions making the impact as envisaged in the project proposals.
- **3**. Auroville units, activities and projects should be equipped to provide transparent and reliable accounts of the expenditure incurred with the contributions received.
- **4**. Upon completion of a project, a comprehensive completion report of project implementation and impact shall be prepared.

6. Administrative costs

- 1. Administrative costs shall be kept as low as possible while ensuring that project accounting, monitoring and reporting are undertaken correctly.
- 2. In the case of certain grants and donations a maximum percentage of total project cost which is permitted as administration and other overhead costs may be provided for in the donation or grant agreement / letter or may be determined by statutory provisions. Such caps on administrative and overhead costs shall be strictly complied with.

7. Utilisation

- 1. When fundraising is done for a specific project or project component, funds received shall be used only for such project or component.
- 2. When unspecified donations are received, utilisation thereof shall be in accordance with Auroville budgets and priorities as may be set by the FAMC from time to time.
- 3. Donations and grants received shall be utilised in full for the Auroville projects for which the donations and grants have been raised and there shall be no retention of any part of the funds received by any of the Auroville entities through which such funds are channelled for administrative, accounting or other purposes.

8. Accounting and Audits

- 1. All Auroville donations and grants shall be received only through the official channels of Auroville Foundation.
- 2. Assets created with donations and grants shall be accounted for as Auroville Foundation assets in the relevant books of account of the concerned unit, activity or project.
- 3. No donations or contributions shall be received by Auroville Foundation or its units, activities and projects for the benefit of an individual. If Auroville residents receive financial support from friends, relatives or others, such contributions must be received by them in their personal bank accounts from where transfers may be made to their Auroville Financial Service account, if so desired by the residents.
- 4. Financial accounting and audits of projects funded with donations and grants shall be undertaken as per guidelines and manuals as issued by the Funds and Assets Management Committee (FAMC) from time to time.
- 5. If a donation or grant agreement provides for a project audit, such audit shall be conducted in addition to regular internal and statutory audits.

9. Income Tax relief

- 1. Auroville Foundation is authorised to issue donation receipts with income tax relief to donors who are taxable in India under sections 80G, 35(i)(ii) and 35(i)(iii) of the Income Tax Act.
- 2. The applicability of each type of income tax relief will depend on the nature of the project for which funds are being raised.

10. Fundraising and expenditure process

- 1. For each project, program or activity for which donations, grants or contributions are sought, the process fundraising and project implementation trajectory will include, but may not be limited to the following steps:
 - a. Check the eligibility of the project proposal in the context of Auroville, its objectives and values;
 - Evaluate the project proposal in terms of costs and sustainability;
 - c. Determine under which section of the Income Tax Act, tax relief can be offered to the prospective donor(s) (80G, 35(1)(ii), 35(1)(iii))) for donations from within India and / or whether the project qualifies as a CSR project with reference to Schedule VII of the Companies Act 2013;
 - d. Approve the fundraising documentation and the prospective donor / contributor target group;
 - e. Raise the funds;
 - f. In the case of foreign contributions, ensure receipt of funds through the dedicated SBI Bank account to be used for this purpose;
 - g. Receive the funds and issue the donation / contribution receipt with tax relief where applicable;
 - Allocate / disburse as already determined earlier in the process;
 - i. Undertake the project and monitor progress;
 - j. Send periodic progress reports to the donor / contributor;
 - k. Prepare the completion report;
 - I. Undertake a project audit, where applicable;
 - m.Do a project completion review (actual vs. plan review; lessons learned etc.; feedback from donor / contributor etc.)

11. Miscellaneous

- 1. FAMC may establish committees, subgroups or service units to implement or monitor implementation of these guidelines or parts thereof.
- 2. These guidelines may be updated or amended by the FAMC from time to time.

REPORT ON SATPREM (SERGE MAINI)

Dear Residents, we to bring to your attention a consolidated report concerning the actions of Mr. Serge Maini, also known as Satprem, that have come to us from different working groups and individuals over the last year.

Satprem, along with a faction, has been involved in a false and abusive campaign, including a doctored video, spreading false information and unsupported facts against the Auroville Foundation, the Secretary, and working groups and residents who support the ongoing work.

The Funds and Assets Management Committee (FAMC) and the Auroville Town Development Council (ATDC) have already reported on Satprem's conduct and work in Auroville. These reports outline his continuous harassment, misconduct, and abuse, which are supported by relevant documents.

Satprem has also taken it upon himself to pass judgment on individuals working and supporting the development of Auroville. He has sent accusatory letters to over 25 people, including members of the ATDC and respected professionals such as Anupama Kundoo, head of ATDC's Urban Design, who received the Global Sustainability Award under the patronage of UNESCO.

We believe that Satprem Maini has misused his position at UNESCO and his privilege of living and working in Auroville, where goodwill towards all is a fundamental requirement. Has fabricated official reports using 'gossip' material.

Unfortunately, Satprem has not ceased his negative behav-

ior. Since the construction work on the Crown development began, he has consistently criticized the ATDC and the Auroville Foundation, positioning himself as an unquestioned authority without the necessary credentials.

He has circulated incorrect interpretations and interfered with the work, even disturbing the CPWD workers on-site and removing paver blocks without permission.

Considering Satprem's own work on roads, particularly the stretch from Certitude leading up to the Solar Kitchen roundabout, it is essential to question the quality and effectiveness of his contributions, as significant amounts of government funds were spent on repeated repairs without improvement and requiring frequent repairs. Additionally, an investigation should be conducted into his 'earth architecture' projects within Auroville's unique climate and material conditions, as well as the reasons why previous ATDCs did not assign him work for over the last ten years.

Satprem is accused of engaging in professional misconduct by practicing and teaching architecture in India without the necessary license from the Council of Architecture, Ministry of Education. A project he undertook in Auroville, inviting newcomer Aurovilians to construct their housing project by themselves using the earthen brick techniques fell apart as most of the persons left the project complaining about his abusive and unprofessional conduct. The increased project cost for paid labor to complete the project cost the community tens of lakhs of Rupees.

In recent months, Satprem's behavior has only worsened. He participated in the Darkali protest and wrote a letter criticizing every aspect of the work, which he publicized through social media and Auroville International channels. He also obtained an internal email discussion between the ATDC and FAMC regarding the correct process for disposing of wood and storage. Obtaining this information through unlawful means raises serious concerns.

The final straw came during the Y20 youth delegation's morning Crown Walk on 5 April when Satprem once again attempted to disrupt and mislead the youth by making false statements.

Working group members, the Secretary of the Auroville Foundation, and for Governing Board member, Shri Anirban Ganguly, witnessed this deplorable episode.

We have previously supported Satprem's work, but we are now extremely concerned about his obstinate and belligerent behavior, which spreads misinformation, confusion, and ill will within the community and wherever he travels. His actions are consistently against the Auroville Foundation, the Secretary and the ongoing work which has faced significant challenges to commence after nearly three decades of blockades, as well as the ATDC, working group members and other Aurovilians. This behavior has proven to be highly detrimental to the overall spirit of Auroville and the necessary goodwill and collaboration required for its harmonious growth and development.

Working Committee has received several written complaints about his disruptive behavior and harassment including instances of public shaming, sending abusive emails, and making derogatory comments toward specific individuals working in the Working Groups and the ones working for the City of Auroville. Please see Manoj Pavithran's personal response to him.

Satprem is alleged to have misused his position and authority within Auroville. This includes exploiting his association with UNESCO to spread negative information, as well as publicly disclosing internal matters of Auronet, potentially causing harm to the community.

Claims have been made regarding Satprem's involvement in physical violence towards nearby villagers, particularly women. The police complaint registered by the locals against Satprem in 2011 can ascertain the veracity of this allegation.

Claims have been made about Satprem using inappropriate and offensive language towards individuals, including sexist and derogatory remarks which are on record. These instances of disrespectful conduct and language raise concerns about his interactions within the community.

Satprem has also engaged himself in unethical practices, such as lobbying with Indian political parties to secure per-

sonal favorable decisions. He has also used his connections to secure projects all over India, while his Visa regulation stipulates him to work only in Auroville.

While he pays his monthly contribution, nothing has been contributed towards the annual 33% contributions from the profits as is required by all unit executives as per CoC 2017. Effectively, he contributes nothing to the community while he erroneously claims to have contributed Rs 75 lakhs.

FAMC gave a summary report—The income is mostly expensed out in salaries and travels. Very small amount is reported as profit and of which nothing is given to the community.

Finally, regarding claims as to what he has given to Auroville, we see no mention of what Auroville has given him all these years: free land, premises, support to run his workshops, goodwill of people, the Foundation and the Mother's presence.

This report summarizes the anti-Auroville actions by Satprem (Serge Maini) based on the information provided by and to the Working Committee, by the different Working Groups, from past records and individuals.

JOURNEY TO THE LIFE DIVINE, PART 2

Monday, 26 June, 4pm at Savitri Bhavan



Duration: 87 min.

Part 2 of the film by the Sri Aurobindo Ashram Pondicherry covers the lives and work of Sri Aurobindo and the Mother from November 1926 until 2010 when the film was released.

To create a new world dedicated to a spiritual life was the Mother's dream already in France. This film is about how the Mother and Sri Aurobindo worked this out in the Ashram. It also reveals the meaning of Sri Aurobindo's withdrawal in 1926 and informs us that at every Darshan time there was a concentration of forces and certain realizations which he wanted to give to the people.

The Mother gifted flowers to the sadhaks to support their growth of consciousness. It was meant to help them to be aware of the states of consciousness represented by each flower—and to enable their souls to blossom and to support the opening of the psychic.

The Sri Aurobindo Ashram is for the sadhana of supramental integral transformation of life to Life Divine, and to establish the Divine Presence on earth based on the teachings of Sri Aurobindo and the Mother. Its true role is pioneering, to inspire and to guide humanity in this special step in evolution of consciousness.

And on 28 February 1968, the Mother inaugurated Auroville, the City of Dawn, as an experiment for living in peace, harmony, goodwill, discipline and truth. The purpose of Auroville is to realize Human Unity based on the teaching of Sri Aurobindo, where men of all countries would be at home.

The Sri Aurobindo Ashram puts a special emphasis on physical education. The Mother explained it thus: "We want to come in contact with the supreme consciousness. The universal consciousness, we want to bring down in our cells and to manifest it. But for that we must have a very solid base. Our base is our physical being, our body. Therefore we have to build up the bodies, solid, healthy, enduring, skilful, strong, joyful, ready for everything." And Sri Aurobindo said, "The body is the base, the pedestal of our terrestrial existence. The longer the body can be made to live by maintaining itself, the strengths and active energies, the more we gain for the sadhana. A divine life in a divine body is the formula of the ideal what we envisioned". He also stated that this Yoga is a silent revolution. A sadhak in this yoga ascends by his realizations from peak to peak progressing silently, like the rising sun. Moreover, the whole human civilisation is now in this silent spiritual revolution.

The film presents various events in the history of the Ashram and its several important activities: how Darshan happens and meditations at the Samadhi, the activities of different karma yoga projects, the arrival of children and the beginning of the Ashram School, the foundation of the Department of Physical Education to coordinate all physical activities in the Ashram, the creation of the Sri Aurobindo International Center of Education as well as the Mother's play of the New Year music and message in 1955. It also gives information about her bringing about the Supramental Manifestation on Earth in February 1956, and the sending of relics to centres of Sri Aurobindo and the Mother in other parts of the world.



BACHELOR'S DEGREE COURSES in Emerging Technologies at Auroville College in Aurobrindavan

Auroville Institute of Applied Technology -Auroville College in Applied Sciences, located at Aurobrindavan in its 2nd year of existence, is taking admission of youth from Auroville and the Bioregion in a Bachelor Degree course (B.Voc.) affiliated with Pondicherry University in the following subjects:



- Software Development & Machine Learning or Artificial Intelligence
- 2. Green Energy and Electric Systems
- 3. Production Technology

AIAT Education is based on learning by doing as per NEP2000 guidelines of UGC. Our learning system is skill-oriented, focused on personality-building and being a solution provider. Our students learn from the people /mentors and would practice at Auroville units.

These courses are conducted in small classes (25-30) students of 3 years duration. During a B.Voc.-course period, students receive three certificates: a Diploma Certificate after one year, an advanced Diploma certificate after two years, and a Bachelor's Degree certificate after three years.

The B.Voc.-curriculum was designed by AIAT and PU faculties. It is approved and published on the PU website. Under this curriculum, 60% of the credits are practical and only 40% is theory. The curriculum includes the latest development in Technology. Each academic year a student is supposed to go to an internship. AIAT has qualified Aurovilan and external faculties and access to facilities at PU. The PU conducts the examinations and certifies.

The external examiner highly appreciated our 1st-year students in the Software Development course for their practical knowledge and theoretical background.

B.E. Vs. B.Voc.

Pondicherry University is implementing NEP 2020 in all its affiliated Colleges. As per NEP 2020 B.E. courses also have a similar concept of multiple entry and exit as B.Voc.. In the 1st 3 years of the B.E. and B.Voc. courses credit points awarded are the same. Also the NCrF-credit level is the same for both at 5.5. Students who have completed 3 years B.Voc. can join in the 4th year a B.E. course to get a B.E. certificate of NCrF-lavel 6.

Auroville College Vs. others colleges

The traditional colleges offer B.E. or B.Tech. courses of 4 year duration. These courses are conducted as per curriculum defined by AICTE, which is very much theory oriented. In general, after passing a B.E. and B.Tech. course many students are finding it difficult to find a job. As published in Statista.com 57% of the Engineering graduates in 2023 are employable. The main reason for unemployment is lack of skills (subject as well as soft skills). Auroville College addresses this issue with a skill and practice oriented curriculum.

Who can join B.Voc. Courses

- Eligible are students who have completed +2 or equivalent courses. Students from Last-school are granted admission in these courses per PU guidelines.
- Students who have passed 10th with min. 50% marks in an ITI course of 2 years can also join a B.Voc. course.
- Pondicherry residents are admitted through CENTAC under the Govt. or Management Quota.

For many years Solitude Farm has run a basket service where we provide a basket of fruits and veg, and greens on a weekly basis.

In this summer season we have papayas, soursop, pineapples, jackfruit, mangos sometimes, guava, a little later there will be chikoos and there are also various vegetables such as

beans and, bottle gourd, pumpkin, brinjals, capsicums, spinach and a bag of mixed greens that we use for Salad st the farm cafe.

If you have a connection to Tamil culture, there are banana flowers, sundakkai (turkey berry), banana stem, green mangoes and more. There is even a juice kit with flowers and leaves that make delicious coolers.

The produce changes through the seasons and we invite participants to come and learn from us how to use produce such as jackfruit seeds or bread fruit, green papayas etc.

 The baskets can be picked up on either Monday, Wednesday or Friday.

The pricing changes depending on how long you subscribe for. A one year subscription is much cheaper than a one month subscription. The baskets are generous in size and can weigh up to 8 kgs, the more you understand local foods, the more produce we are able to give!

If you would like to eat food that has no carbon footprint and does not harm Mother Earth, food that is equally tasty and also reflects the values of Ayurveda, often addressing problems such as Diabetes and other such diseases, then the basket service is a great local solution for sourcing organic and most importantly local produce.


STUDIES FOR AUROVILLE circa 1980



During my time in Auroville, and sometimes afterwards, as various design and town planning ideas were openly being discussed, I would explore and develop studies and communicate them to the community and people I thought may be interested through the newsletters and other publications and presentations at meetings. When I became aware of a decision apparent by the start of construction I would stop those studies and go on to some other design and town planning study. Looking back my sense is that I was not in on the private discussions and decision making. Now many years later, some of the drawings and writings that have survived with me are presented.

Urban Spaces/ Squares in the crown

The squares in the crown town planning study, originally called plazas on the crown, were integral with the petal parks idea and based on the existing land and developments at that time, the early 1980's. I was working with Dorothee and a few people organizing



land maps, several green-workers, and surveying for water conservation projects partly funded by the Tamil Nadu Forest Department, and developed a fairly comprehensive sense of the land and existing buildings.



The nine squares seem to fit, at the intersection of radial roads, and in part formed a crown reference diameter. Part of the idea was by building the squares/plazas on the crown first, vehicles can come in to the plazas, and go out from the plazas, and movement from square to plaza to piazza could be quieter and easily controlled.

This is not, however, what Mother meant! She meant that our life is death itself, i.e., there is no "other side"; we're already in death! Or, to put it differently, we are on the wrong side [The Matrix] and life has yet to be. ...

We are in a universal black dungeon, invisible to us, and we go about in that dungeon as a matter of course, thinking it is our daylight and our life, making all kinds of "wonderful" discoveries, even peering at the whole universe through the dungeon walls, using the ingredients of the dungeon to accomplish atomic, electronic, and medical "miracles," even flying through the air of the dungeon and tinkering with genetics in an attempt to improve our nocturnal species—whereupon the dungeon disintegrates.

And something else emerges. Something else entirely.

We had never been born, never been "men"—we were merely hemeralopes, like the axolotls in the underground lakes of Mexico. We had never seen the daylight, never seen life. We were living dead.

Then our walls crumble.

And it's another Earth.

It is "another heaven," as John of Patmos had seen.

It is the Day, as the Vedic rishis saw some five or seven thousand years ago.

They shattered the mountain rock with

their cry;

They made in us a path...

They discovered the Day and the sun-

world...

the pregnant hill [our own matter, our dungeon]... parted asunder,

heaven was perfected."

Dear Friends, I was summoned on Monday, 19 June to the FRRO in Chennai. I was told that the Secretary revoked the recommendation for my stay in Auroville. Initially, she wanted me to leave within a week.

I tried to present some papers and explain things... But there was no way.

The FRRO officers were kind and understanding. But they simply said that they received the order to issue an exit permit and I had to go.

However, they also added that in view of what I did for India, they would give me 2 weeks to leave India. Thus, I will be leaving on 30 June. ~75 Lakhs Rs. to Auroville from my savings, created Crores of Rs. of assets in Auroville and made the Auroville Earth Institute one of the world leaders in the field of earth architecture...

And now I am thrown out like a piece of garbage by this "civil servant".

My departure means also the end of the Auroville Earth Institute: Half of the courses cannot be given if I am not here and our main income is coming from the works that I do outside for which the fees have always been given to Auroville.

Auroville is my home and India is my country.

The majority of foreigners and most of the Tamil people are asleep, and never say a word or attend meetings. When will finally wake up ALL the Aurovilians and fight for the Truth and the Auroville ideal?




