HOUSE OF MOTHER'S AGENDA



10 October 1964

As Satprem prepares to leave, Mother inquires about his health:

Mother: ... Now, the last stage is that the body should forget it has been ill; that's very important.

Satprem: Very difficult.

Mother: It's very important.

Satprem: I am constantly struggling against pernicious suggestions. This physical mind gives me a lot of

trouble - a lot of trouble. It has terrible apprehensions and fears.

Mother: Oh, absolutely.

Satprem: You understand, it has received so many blows...

Mother: Exactly!

Satprem: ... that it lives in an anxiety which ruins everything.

Mother: Yes, yes.

Satprem: What can you do?!

Mother: Persist.

I saw it in my own case. It was interesting enough, because from my earliest childhood, I was in contact with the higher consciousness (gesture above the head) and in a real stupefaction at the state of the earth and people - when I was very little. I was in a stunned amazement all the time. And the blows I received!... Constantly. Each thing came to me as a stab or a punch or a hammer blow, and I would say to myself, "What? How is this possible?" You know, all the baseness, all the lies, all the hypocrisy, all that is crooked, all that distorts and undoes the flow of the Force. And I would see it in my parents, in circumstances, in friends, in everything - a stupefaction. It wasn't translated intellectually: it was translated by that stupefaction. And when I was very little, the Force was already there (gesture above the head); I have a clear memory from the age of five: I only had to sit down for a moment to feel it, that Force which would come. And I went through the whole of life, up to the age of twenty or twenty-one (when I began to encounter Knowledge and someone who explained to me what it all was) like that, in that stupefaction: "What - is this life? What - is this what people are? What...?" And I was as though beaten black and blue, mon petit!

Then, from the age of twenty or twenty-five, that habit of pessimism began. It took all that time, all those blows, for it to come.

But with regard to health, whenever I had an illness (for me it was never an "illness," it was still part of the blows), I had a trust, a complete assurance that it had no reality. And very young (very young, maybe around the age of thirteen or fourteen), every time a blow came, I would tell my body, "But what's the use of being ill since you'll just have to get well!" And that stayed until I was over thirty: what's the use of being ill since you have to get well? And it faded away only little by little, with that growing pessimism.

Now I have to undo all that work.

But with you, it's the same thing, because you were already conscious when you were small (without being conscious of it), and when all those terrible things (Mother is alluding to the concentration camps) happened to you, there was something that remained conscious, but those things "cultivated" the pessimism - that pessimism of the physical mind. And now you have to undo all that work. And what a work it is, phew!...

You understand, it was **IMPOSSIBLE**, impossible for me to believe in ("believe" - even understand) all those movements of betrayal, of jealousy, all the movements of negation of the Divine in human beings and things - it was impossible, I didn't understand! But it came from every side, striking and striking and striking.... So all that had to be undone.

And with you, it was the same thing - I know it very well. I know it very well. And for you it took brutal forms.

But we only have to hold out, that's all.

We must erase the imprint little by little. And in fact, the only way to erase the imprint is to make contact with the Truth. There is no other way - all reasoning, all intelligence, all understanding, all that is totally useless with this physical mind. The only thing is to make contact. That's just what the cells value: the possibility of making contact. Making contact.

On the material level, japa is very good for that. When your head is tired and you are a little weary of forever contradicting that pessimism, you just have to repeat your japa, and automatically you make contact. To make contact. That's something the cells value a lot. A lot. It's a very good way, because it's a way that isn't mental, it's a mechanical way, it's a question of vibration.

There, mon petit, we must endure.

WORKING GROUP REPORTS

From the WC re: Solidarity movement

There are times when there is a need to stand together and show a strong, silent presence to care for the physical reality of Auroville. When there is a dispute over land or assets of Auroville, when members of our community are being harassed or threatened by outsiders, then there should be a rapid and direct way to alert each other that there is a need to come to the site and demonstrate quiet solidarity and strength.

Some of you may remember that many years ago there was a similar call and a list of almost 50 Aurovilians was compiled who would be willing to be called in such situations. We would now like to update this list and revive the Solidarity Movement. The 2 main bodies that may use this list are the AVSST and the Land Board. The names of those who come forward will be shared with these 2 groups and they will then contact individuals as needed to brief them and explain the expectations.

Please be aware that this is not a call to get directly involved in the issues and that the lead of the AVSST and Land Board, depending on the situation, would need to be respected at all times. It is simply to be a presence if it is felt it could be helpful. From the AVC: Follow up on proposal C (FAMC members)

The selection process for the members of FAMC as per the proposal C, presented by the ABC and ABS, requires amendments in the existing mandate of FAMC. We will invite 3 members of the community to be a part of this Task Force that will consist of members of ABC, ABS, and members of FAMC to cocreate a revised FAMC mandate. -The Auroville Council.

RESIDENTS' ASSEMBLY DECISION MAKING PROCESS METHOD FOR SELECTING WORKING GROUP MEMBERS

This Residents' Assembly Decision making process (RAD) is for the community to agree the method of selection for working group members. The selection for working group membership is due to take place before the end of the year as a number of existing members' terms are ending.

With multiple proposals to be considered, this decision making process first seeks consent from the community to deviate from the 50% in-favour threshold for agreeing the method of selection. If accepted, the proposal A, B or D that receives the most votes will be regarded as the community decision, even if that proposal gets less than 50% of votes in favour. If the community chooses to use the 50% decision-making threshold (as per the RAD policy 2007 (https://bit.ly/3jWCL74) default), it will require one of the proposals A, B or D to receive at least 50% of votes in favour to be registered as the community decision. If no proposal is successful in the first round, there will be further rounds to determine whether one of the proposals can reach 50% votes in favour. Further details will be set out with the launch of the RAD on Saturday 7th.

Proposal C presented by ABC/ABS representatives was focused on the selection of a representative form of membership for FAMC, followed by a review of the mandate. With the expected formation of the FAMC mandate review Taskforce, which includes proposal C stakeholders, it has been decided to withhold proposal C from this RAD, pending assurances from the Auroville Council about the Taskforce. The FAMC mandate, including membership selection, is expected to be brought back to the community within 4 months, with an RAD on the proposal(s) for change.

WHAT ARE THE PROPOSALS ASKING FOR?

Proposal A (<u>https://bit.ly/3emlzWa</u>) replaces the method of selecting working group members currently set out in the PWG 2018 (<u>https://bit.ly/3mQlQnc</u>).

Proposal B (<u>https://bit.ly/34Ssh48</u>) replaces the full PWG 2018 (<u>https://bit.ly/3mQlQnc</u>) with the suggested method of selecting working group members.

Proposal D (<u>https://bit.ly/2EIF5ji</u>) replaces the method of selecting working group members currently set out in the PWG 2018 (<u>https://bit.ly/3mQIQnc</u>).

Please fill your ballot out and hand it over to the RAS members / resource persons (at the RAS desk) every Tuesday between 10am to 12pm. In-person voting (meeting of the Residents' Assembly) will be organized at **Solar Kitchen on Saturday, November 21, 11am - 2pm**.

TDC quarterly report - July, Aug & Sep 2020

This report covers the work undertaken by our team from July to end of September 2020. Our previous work is detailed in our Jan-June 2020 report (see <u>https://auroville.org.in/article/80803</u>). This report is intended to bring the community up to date on where we are & support informed, positive discussions on how we can move forward. It provides a snapshot of our recent work.

Summary

During this period we have continued to face significant resource challenges, with just two Interface Team members \mathfrak{A} a major, ongoing funding shortage. This has been a difficult time for the team but we have used the resources available to progress our work areas as best we can. Key areas of work undertaken in this time include:

- Draft Detailed Development Plan for Residential Zone 1 & 2
 - Housing survey
- Exploration of faecal sludge management options
- Empanelment of contractors
- Land use map

Design approval is not an NOC to start construction but an evaluation of the design & preliminary estimates submitted. The applicant / project holder is to submit the final building NOC form and full set of construction drawings along with detailed estimates for a final building NOC after the approval is given .

Colours of Nature - shed - Celebration - Application for Preliminary design approval. The design approval shall be given to Colours of Nature to build a shed above the existing tailoring section of total area of 207 sqm and preliminary estimate of 10,18,730.00/-. The funds to create the roof above existing structure were created by the unit itself, and with it they would like to provide better workable conditions of the existing premises, i.e. Manufacturing (tailoring unit). The design for the shed was done by Hari Engineering.

From the BCC re: Diwali Bonus

Dear Services, the BCC has discussed the question of the Diwali bonus and looked at the legal implications of this. Bonus for the year 20-21 needs to be paid in full by the end of the financial year (March 21). However, any employee receiving Rs 21,000 or more as basic wages is legally not eligible for Bonus. BCC recommends to pay the usual Diwali bonus based on the past 12 months' salary.

The usual amount of Diwali bonus is 2 weeks pay on current wages. If your employee has changed salary (in the last 3 months) then a different calculation could be used for the bonus:

- add up the total salary of the last twelve months,
- divide that by 12 for an average monthly salary, then

take half of that as the Diwali bonus amount. The other half is to be paid as a Pongal bonus



Bharat Nivas activity report - Oct. 2020

BHARAT NIVAS The Bharat Nivas campus has been officially closed since the lockdown started in March, due to the Coronavirus epidemic situation. In October regular activities started to resume, respecting the proper protocols to

prevent the further spread of Covid-19. Here is some news from the Bharat Nivas campus from the month of October 2020:

Sri Aurobindo Centre for Studies

• A few small gatherings were held in Bhumika Hall, including working group meetings, lecture and presentation, a collective Zoom session on fundraising and a meeting and program of the Sanskritam Auroville group, with both in-person and distant (online) participants.

• Sanskrit classes with limited participants resumed for Aurovilians, Newcomers & Volunteers, including "Introduction to Sanskrit" classes and a class on "The Bhagavad Gita through Sanskrit".

 The Resource Library is currently open by appointment only. Kalakendra

• An exhibition on tribal Indian handicrafts/home decor was held.

 Painting classes/ workshops for small groups of children were conducted.

• Regular clean-up and maintenance was managed with the help of a few volunteers. Works to prevent and control water leakages are in progress.

Sri Aurobindo Auditorium

• A few urgent roof repairs were completed, but much work remains still to be done after the monsoon is over.

• Other urgent clean-up, repairs and maintenance was undertaken.

• The auditorium is still closed for public programs. Restarting of public programs is being looked at for January 2021.

SAWCHU & Progress Hall - Regular classes for Aurovilians, Newcomers, volunteers & children resumed, including Ashtanga Yoga, Capoeira & Dance classes (Bharatnatyam, Odissi, Hip Hop).

Harmony Hall - Civil works renovating the newly named "Harmony Hall" were completed, with a new wooden floor suitable for dance and asana classes. The hall will eventually be equipped with audio-visual materials and will also be able to be used for working group meetings, small seminars, workshops, presentations and other types of activities. This was funded by grant from the Government of India.

Atithi Griha Guesthouse - Expansion of the guesthouse adding a new first floor to the existing buildings was completed. This will allow greater occupancy in the guesthouse when guest activity resumes and increase the financial self-sufficiency of the Bharat Nivas campus. This was funded by grant from the Government of India.

Sharanam -Sharanam dormitory adjacent to Atithi Griha GH continued to be used as a Covid-19 quarantine facility for Aurovilians.

Tamil Heritage Centre - Work on construction of the Tamil Heritage Centre was ongoing during the month of October.

Campus General

• Ongoing challenges were faced with regard to retrenching of employed workers due to lack of funds. The campus is currently being maintained by Aurovilians and volunteers.

• Campus maintenance repair and upgrade work was reviewed and some repairs were completed.

Administration

• Annual accounts of the Bharat Nivas Trust were prepared and consolidated for all the activities on the campus. These were submitted to the Auroville Foundation.

• Utilization Completion paperwork for the constructions funded by government grant were submitted.

• The grants and financial support for the Bharat Nivas campus is being reviewed to sustain in the long-term the maintenance of Aurovilians working in Bharat Nivas and ongoing urgent repairs and maintenance.

• The Bharat Nivas Trustees and team members resumed weekly meetings to bring the Bharat Nivas campus back to life, for the new use of the upgraded facilities for Auroville and the International Zone.

From the Water Group:

A comparison of water levels in some Auroville wells

A comparison of water levels in wells, between January 2020 and September 2020 has been compiled in the table below. As you all know, the period between the last monsoon and before the incoming monsoon usually receives little rain, so the recharge of wells is very limited: it is a good opportunity to see the human impact on the water level here in Auroville.


A map has been compiled as well, showing locations of these wells, with symbols size proportional to the water level difference. It needs to be noted the substantial difference in levels in the North-Western region of Auroville, where water levels have significantly dropped most probably due to overextraction in neighbouring non-Auroville wells, and consequent deepening of the water table level in guite a large area.

Looking at the differences of water levels, the Water Group invites everyone to use water very consciously, with carefulness, avoiding any unnecessary consumption and minimizing any possible wastage. Another analysis will be conducted taking into account the water levels of wells immediately after the monsoon, to evaluate the recharge occurred because of the rain. It needs to anyhow be kept in mind that interpretation of these kind of data is far from easy, as many several factors, time - and spacedepending, are involved.

THE GREEN COLUMN NEWS FLASH

<u>Biodiversity meets the Pandemic:</u> The UN declared 2011-2020 <u>The</u> <u>Decade on Biodiversity</u>. This was adopted at the COP 10 in Achi, Japan. This decade is almost over and the world failed to achieve most of the targets to preserve and restore its different life forms. There has been virtually no progress in minimizing anthropogenic (human caused) pressures on coral reefs and other vulnerable ecosystems impacted by climate change and ocean acidification and safeguarding ecosystems that provide essential services including those related to water, health, livelihoods and well-being. Meanwhile, the <u>Intergovernmental Science-Policy</u> <u>Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services</u> (IPBES), an independent intergovernmental body comprising over 130 member governments, says unsustainable exploitation of the environment has led to almost all pandemics and calls for system change.

<u>USA Elections:</u> Donald Trump's re-election would be catastrophic for the Climate Movement. But what will Joe Biden's presidency entail? He takes the middle ground aiming to appease both parties, pledging to achieve 100 % clean electricity by 2035, spending \$ 2 trillion over 4 years to boost renewable energy. His running mate Kamala Harris endorsed the Green New Deal, supported a ban on fracking and by 2021 wants to negotiate an international phase-out of fossil fuel subsidies. Her climate plan needs \$ 10 trillion.

<u>Flash Droughts:</u> are dry spells within the monsoon season and have a devastating effect on agriculture. A flash drought can develop in as little as 10-15 days, caused by rapid evapotranspiration due to extreme heat, wind and incoming solar radiation. Madhya Pradesh and Odisha had 40 % deficit in rainfall and lost 15 % of their Soybean-rice and maize crops. When rains returned in August, they were so heavy that farmers again suffered crop damage.

<u>Coal mining:</u> Over the last 5 years, 29 coal mines were allotted or auctioned under the Coal Mines (Special Provisions) Act of

which 14 are operational, sometimes located under hard fought for tribal wildlife preserves and mostly outsourced to private companies in an unregulated and non-transparent manner. Many countries are phasing out coal based power because it causes climate change and respiratory diseases.


