

HOUSE OF MOTHER'S AGENDA



(continued from last week)

19 April 1970

The Mother: And, you know, the faces, expressions, gestures, movements, words - as precise, as precise as they are here. It seems to be a response... because I asked (it was yesterday, I think, sometime yesterday; in fact when I sit like that, as I was with you the other day, the two worlds are fused [Mother holds the fingers of her right hand between those of her left hand], you can't feel the difference), I asked Sri Aurobindo whether things are as precise and exact; so he told me yes, he answered yes, but said I had to experience it. And I had that experience last night, quite unexpectedly. It was around three in the morning (between two and three).

So then, I saw this morning one person from the family in question, who could have been one of those seriously ill - she didn't mention anything, didn't say anything.... So maybe it began in sleep for her and the action [of Mother] was enough to cure her without her realizing it. It's possible.

You understand, it's the kind of consciousness that says, "My body is suffering," but it wasn't my body, it was someone else's body. It said, "I am suffering, but I know it's not me, it's the suffering of one member of this family" (I didn't try to find out which), "and that's why - it's because I must do what I would do in my own case." And I did it, it lasted for two hours.

It's the first time. It's like that every night, but fleeting, it comes for one detail, for a moment; the rest of the time I am in perfect Peace. It's the first time I've had an action of this sort. And I was so ill (!) that I wondered (while it lasted), I wondered if I wouldn't be left with something physically. That's why, when I felt I had to get up, I thought it was also deliberate; I got up and I realized - nothing!

But it gives indications (more and more often, day after day, experience after experience), indications of the extent to which the intervention of this Will (which we call divine Will) through the psychic (or even direct, it depends on the case), to what extent it's... all-powerful. And it exclusively depends on... This Will is always active for perfect Harmony - yes, perfect Harmony as we can conceive it. There also, in this conception, there is the knowledge that that too will progress, that once that harmony is manifested, then the work will begin for another perfection, which for the moment eludes us. That, too, knows.

More and more, there's a sort of... not exactly fusion [between the subtle physical and the material physical], but... how should I put it?... For everything to hold together, this way of being of the material consciousness continues (the material, physical consciousness), but in it a permeation takes place (it really is a permeation), which doesn't drive away the other, but... at length, it will probably transform it. It doesn't drive it [the material consciousness] away, but it's there and it dominates - at times it doesn't dominate, it's the other one that does; and so, depending on the case... it changes external circumstances (its hard to explain).

Satprem: It changes external circumstances? The Mother: External. Satprem: Ohh!... The Mother: External. That permeation certainly intends (but this is probably a long way off) to effect a substitution, you understand? This subtle physical is working... (Mother gestures as if wearing away a dividing wall) to take the place of the other one, but not through elimination - through transformation. But I can see (as I perceive the two at the same time, I can see very clearly) that it's a tremendous work.

And it takes away some of the fixity: our physical is not only fixed, it's crumbly, and the subtle physical takes away that crumbly character: wherever it would break, now it bends, you understand? Wherever it would crumble, it's fluid, it becomes... (Mother makes a fluid gesture). It's very strange. It's hard to explain.

I asked myself that question, I wondered, "But how? How is it going to...?" (Mother probably means, How is the transition going to be made?) So, with these experiences, I see. But, of course, it's a colossal work....

The body [Mother's] has certainly been chosen as a field of experiment for some reason, which must be a reason of plasticity of the substance (I don't know). There may be a reason, but in any case it's a fact that it has been chosen to make the experiment. Because the experiment is under way: it starts with the more subtle, and you can see that it goes... (Mother makes a gesture of progressive descent into Matter). For months and months it has started with the more subtle, and then, VERY slowly and progressively, it has descended into a more material field. Last night, it was really remarkable.... One would have been unable to say, "This is the subtle physical, and that is the material physical." It was... (Mother holds the fingers of her right hand tightly in those of her left hand), it was surprisingly one within the other. You don't get the impression of TWO things, yet it's very different - it seems to be a modality rather than a difference (I don't know how to express it), a modality that comes exclusively from the consciousness. It's a phenomenon of consciousness.

We would like to update you regarding our current position about laying of HT Cable and the Crown area around Bliss. As you may be aware, a General Meeting has been called by the Forest Group and Youth Center seeking an alternate route for laying the HT cable. L'avenir d'Auroville would like to clarify that the real issue on the table for town implementation is not about a cable, but about the Crown. Infrastructure services are planned to be laid on both sides of the Crown way. The HT cable just happens to be the first of such service lines.

L'avenir d'Auroville will implement the Crown as per the Auroville Master Plan and Galaxy Vision. In this respect, L'avenir d'Auroville will conduct a topographic survey for the area and will mark wherever necessary the Crownway at the earliest. The HT cable (and other underground services) will be installed in the designated Crown service corridors as defined by the Master Plan.

The L'avenir d'Auroville team has explored alternate sites for appropriate youth activities. The L'avenir d'Auroville team is also ready to work with interested Aurovilians on the design of the green areas that are planned on both sides of this particular Crown segment.

Sri Aurobindo's 150th Birth Anniversary: An Update

Last August, the previous Working Committee put out a word inviting people to be part of a core group to celebrate Sri Aurobindo's 150th birth anniversary and some names were collected. The second announcement, in December 2020. specified that Auroville would not be seeking grants from GOI but raise funds internally for programs. try to

This February, the Auroville Foundation received a request to send names from Auroville to be part of an endeavor at the national level, under the Ministry of Culture. The names of 5 Aurovilians have been forwarded by the Auroville Foundation Office to be part of a Core Group: Anu, Christine, Juergen, Hemant and Meenakshi. This core group will now work with a larger group of Aurovilians to see what kind of program we want to propose and develop further, both as part of the celebration of the country and internally in Auroville. No budget has been asked and we will wait and see how things develop.

Sri Aurobindo's 150th corresponds with India's 75th year of independence and the 50th year for Bharat Nivas which brings a special emphasis for Auroville in 2022. Some very good ideas are already on board and these will be shared once the Core Team meets with the larger interested group that is to be formed next to take things forward. We welcome your feedback.



The Citizens' Assembly goes public

The last session of the pilot Citizens' Assembly, which initially was tasked to come up with a water vision for

Auroville and subsequently also suggested ways in which it could be implemented, happened on 23rd January. Since then, the CA organizing team and some of the participants had a meeting with the water players to present the assembly's outputs and to get their feedback.

The response was positive. However, there was concern about how the ideas suggested by the group would be taken forward to help Auroville realise the vision. A team is now forming to take up this task. In the meantime, the CA organizing team would like to present a comprehensive overview of the Citizens' Assembly pilot project - including an explanation of the concept, why we chose to experiment with it in Auroville, the process that was followed, the final outputs, as well as participants' feedback - to the larger community.

This will happen on Tuesday, 16th March at 4 pm in the Unity Pavilion. All are welcome to hear about this fascinating project and its potential to reinvigorate and improve our collective deliberation and decision-making process.

Further presentations on different aspects of the project will follow.

- On Thursday 18th March there will be a screening of a documentary film about the making of this Citizens' Assembly at 4.30 pm in Cinema Paradiso. This will be followed by a question and answer session and discussion with the filmmakers and members of the CA organizing team.
- On Monday 22nd March, on the occasion of World Water Day, there will be an exploration of the Assembly's water vision and ideas for implementation with Auroville's water players and other key stakeholders, culminating in a celebratory public

gathering and presentation of the water outcomes between 4 pm and 6 pm in the Unity Pavilion.

- On 26th March the 'Making of the Citizens' Assembly' film will be shown again as part of women's empowerment month.
- And on Saturday, 27th March, as part of the organization day of "Calling Mother's Auroville" event, the focus will be upon presenting the Citizens' Assembly process, and exploring its potential not only for increasing the range of residents' participation but also the quality of our collective deliberations and decision-making.

We 're back with another young naturalist. This time we meet Oliver, a 4th grader in Deepanam and a keen observer of his environment. He can be seen in this picture taking a well- deserved rest at a Community Garden.

Some Obvious Solutions by Oliver Mo

I feel that what humanity has to do is obvious; we just don't understand how grave this situation really is. Forests that are

hundreds of thousands of years old are being cut down just to make the paper I am writing on. For what? Profit. Many big companies are so greedy, lazy and selfish that they are blocking alternative better methods that save water, power, money, and land, whilst advertising themselves as environmentally friendly. For example, land that would be spared from just changing what we use to make our 'normal paper' could be used to re-establish once great bio-diverse forests.

Another topic: the stuff that fuels our lives, food. In today's world much of our food is brought on planes from countries across the globe grown from G.M.O (Genetically Modified Organism) crops. The best climate solution for this issue is local farming. In the 2020 Covid lockdown gardens were started all over Auroville. People started working together, giving a real sense of community, which I feel we can still improve on in Auroville today. Also, just knowing where your food comes from, in addition to helping the earth, feels good. Our minds have been corrupted thinking we need apples, pears, oranges, etcetera, anytime, anywhere.

I feel that as humanity as a whole we need to set a standard, and create the new normal. We are becoming uneducated; growing apart from nature, thinking we aren't nature. Teachers have one of the most important jobs in the world. They have to teach the next generation about everything from dolphins to dictionaries. Stuff that matters. We still have people who don't understand the importance of plumbers, electricians and farmers. Fortunately, some governments are trying to change things so we will not end up living in a world of only managers, traders, artists, and so on.

The last thing I want to cover is energy and transport. One problem with electric cars that you can charge from your house is that most of the electricity in your house is not clean energy. And if your house does run on solar or wind it normally does not generate enough power for a car. But with the evolution of technology, solar panels will probably eventually be able to produce more power, car batteries will be able to store more power, and it would all be cheaper than now. But this will all take a while and in that time I worry that fossil fuel industries may try to stop this process.

THE START OF SUMMER

This summer promises to be hot according to the India Meteorological Institute (IMD)...

With the sun moving through the Northern Hemisphere since the Winter Solstice, the days are getting longer, and after a good monsoon, with a blessing of 16 cm of rain on Mother 's birthday, our water catchment areas have been replenished. The kolam in Aurodam still has 3 meters of water(!) and invites for a cool swim. Summer is upon us again, with all its joys and tribulations; pesticide spraying, power cuts, road works and more.

What are the predictions for the coming months? The IMD has issued a national forecast called 'Seasonal Outlook for

temperatures for March to May 2021'. The season ahead is expected to be warmer than usual over most regions of India except some southern states (including Tamil Nadu). Most regions along the North, Northwest, East and Northeast India will experience above normal maximum temperatures during March, April and May. India is prone to heat waves, which are declared when the maximum temperature rises over 4 degrees from normal. It is not possible to predict the exact number of heatwave events, expanse or intensity in a Seasonal Outlook, which covers three months. "Some of these regions fall under the Core Heatwave Zone. So, these states should expect normal or even more heatwave events this year. The heatwave predictions and their intensity can best be forecast as the season progresses" stated a IMD official.

<u>Pesticide Spraying</u> - Many of us are very sensitive with streaming eyes, sore throats and a general feeling of malaise. This is not Covid, but can be the fall- out of the cashew pesticide spraying. It is very disheartening that no matter how much energy Auroville has put into preventing such practices since years (including offering natural alternatives) the cashew pesticide spraying frenzy continues unabated. There is a <u>Cashew Alert group on WhatsApp</u> where Aurovilians living near sprayed village cashew fields can report and warn of oncoming tractors ready to get into action, with date /time and location and if possible chemicals used. Some people and small children are so sensitive they have to temporarily move to a cleaner area...

So it's not time yet to put away your covid masks. But a wetted scarf also helps! And finally we recommend the homeopathic remedy Oukabaka available for free in Prathna Homeopathic Pharmacy.

SILENT TEACHING



The exhibition "Sadhaks of Integral Yoga", on display at the Town Hall since January, will be over on March 22. I took those photographs in 1983-4, at the Sri Aurobindo Ashram, to imprint in my memory the faces of those who have been my silent inspirers and guides by example. To them I return, whenever I feel it is all over and we need a new cycle, with the same people taking birth once more with the Avatar: whenever dharma is lost and humanity is to be rescued from adharma.

I look at those faces then I know that the Path is not utopia, those are the people; they lived, and realised. Watching them I learnt - not through books or lectures, no, through the silent example of their daily offering - what the Integral Yoga is: every day repeating at the same time the same actions, with the same people; talking only when indispensable for the work to be done; in utmost concentration, serving the Divine at the best of one's capacities, wishing no other reward but communion through service.

Meditation, speeches, classes, art and all other external things any of these are optional, ex tempore: karmayoga comes first. Work in an atmosphere of concentrated silence is concluded by training of the body involving all ashramites, in batches, up to the most seniors. It was them, the elderly, whom I saw every time when entering the Playground bi-weekly collective meditation; quite a sight.

Integral Yoga is the divinisation of all parts and planes of being in life, in work, in society; fully concentrated on the Divine 24/24, even during sleep - not remote flights on the moon; not meditations and techniques leaving the outer being as gross as before. Integral Yoga is the sacral repetition of routine, even most trivial action by inward concentration upon the supreme goal; for in truth there is nothing, being or action, that is not divine if only we merge with the essence, sheer divinity. Crossing a street, going to the market, on the battlefield as in one's bed, cleaning one's teeth as washing dishes or doing scholarly research, every single second is to be lived concentrated within. Microcosm and macrocosm, within and without, above and below are words. In truth there is but THAT, one without a second, the One and All, in sleep as in the dream or the waking state.

This was the theme of the collages of dry flowers and grasses I did, on Ashram's marbling boards. It took me an average of three days, eight hours a day, to complete one: the Many, the Two, the One. Same theme of the poems I wrote in the hollow of the Samadhi tree, where I spent hours every day (attempts to dislodge me from there having failed). I had breakfast and lunch at Tout ce qu'il faut, a restaurant for non-vegetarian pilgrims that Purna, Mother's granddaughter, had opened with her blessings. On my way there - every single step in utter concentration - twice a day I collected flowers and grasses for my collages; enthralled by every pebble, every spot on the sidewalk and walls, the play of light and shadow... all was but That, divinity in every form, from densest matter to wandering clouds in the sky... even the sewages under the scorching sun, even the pigs those years still roaming around the frail huts had a remote beauty... This is what the place radiated, without the need of the physical presence of the Guru, without the need of any teaching, any reading, so palpable was God within each and all and everything...

Day in and day out, since ever and forever I was, I am, we are. The One and the Two and the Many. THAT we are. As a hymn of devotion and gratitude to Their sadhaks, they, who taught me by silence, in silence, like Dakshinamurti, the essence and bliss of Integral Yoga, in mystical communion: microcosm and macrocosm are One.




