NEW SET OF COVID LOCKDOWN GUIDELINES

Valid until 31 December

Dear Community, the Honorable Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has issued a new set of Covid lockdown guidelines valid until 31st December. These are the key indications:

- Schools from 6th to 12th class will be operating normally from January 3rd without a rotation system
- All colleges and technical colleges will operate as per usual procedure without rotation.
- Meeting halls will be allowed to be used for all the permitted activities.
- People should avoid gathering during the festive season considering the spread of omicron.
- No public access to Tamil Nadu beaches on 31st December and January 1st.
- Public events such as social, cultural and political gatherings will continue to be banned.
- All swimming pools will be allowed to operate.

Please remember to continue to apply all due precautions of wearing masks and maintaining distance when interacting with others and in public spaces/facilities, and regularly washing hands or using sanitizer.





Aurobindo, Mother and Satprem, as well as research on Indian culture and history and authored a few books. Michel is a visiting professor at IIT Gandhinagar (Gujarat), where they are living and he recently became a member of the Auroville International Advisory Council.

NOTE: The Newcomer probation year becomes effective only after the NC kit has been returned and should not exceed 18 months from the date of confirmation.

A Newcomer becomes an Aurovilian once his/her name has been confirmed by The Admission Committee (aka the Entry Board) after following due process.

The date of becoming Aurovilian is the date of confirmation. An Aurovilian confirmed by the Entry Board is eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes.

A confirmed Aurovilian becomes officially a Resident of Auroville once the individual has filled in and signed the B-Form and his/her name has been entered in the Register of Residents (RoR) maintained by the Auroville Foundation Office (AVF).

A Resident of Auroville is eligible to become an executive of a Unit or Service of Auroville and to get an ID card issued by the Auroville Foundation.

A meeting with the Secretary of the AVF will be arranged by the Entry Secretariat according to the availability of the Secretary and not at any personal request.

On January 7th, 2022 BCC will start a participatory budgeting process to get input from the community on our overall priorities for the City Services budget. These inputs will inform the allocation process.

We hope all of you will participate by attending the first presentation, to be held at Unity Pavilion on Friday, January 7th from 4:30 – 6:00pm.

PEGGY RUSTOMJI PASSED AWAY

In the early morning of 15 December, Peggy, the mother of Jehangir and Rishad Rustomji, first generation of students of Auroville, passed away in her home in Kodaikanal. Both her sons were with her during the time of transition.

Some of us affectionately remember her sitting in the school bus that would bring students and teachers from the Ashram and Pondicherry to Auroville in the seventies, – in those halcyon days when we embarked on the Auroville adventure on an empty canvas.

RAINWATER HARVESTING & MONSOON 2021



So far, we measured 2687 mm in Gaia's Garden after more than 100 days of rain. Several times basins flowed over regularly. The soil got saturated and communities and their inhabit-

ants suffered from flooding roads, paths and houses. I was asked to come to several and give advice.

Darkali is getting too much water inflow from Matrimandir area. One of their well created waterbodies is disputed and we hope to improve their overall water catchment in the coming year.

Transition school. Michael Mason created a rainwater harvesting system 20 years ago. The whole system needs to be upgraded, improved and extended.

Shanti & Sincerity. Their houses and paths were flooded by too much rain, which the area could not cope with. Percolation ponds and some bunds are needed. The paths were eroded, so it will be good to raise the paths with soil from the new ponds.

In Aurodam Li Mei suffered from water inundation as her house is situated in a low lying area. The soil hardly percolates and streams were flowing around. A swale with bunding may help for future floods.

Adventure got water from all sites and the houses were heavily flooded. It needs several percolation ponds and the roads need to be raised with the soil from the ponds. Bunds are needed to prevent further inflow.

Then we walked with Angad to improve that area in order to prevent future floods.

Are we going to receive more rains, torrential rains and cloudbursts in the coming years? Is this the new normal? Indications are there and it is not normal. What it tells us now is that we better prepare and maintain our water systems properly by desilting, extending and deepening where needed.

The atmosphere in the room was peaceful and collaborative. All agreed on the need to bridge the disagreements by using compassionate and peaceful courage to bring everyone back to their true centre, which perhaps got lost in the painful events.

Collaboration is the only way forward.

It has been affirmed the necessity to suggest to Madam Secretary a pause for reflection so as not to escalate more the tensions and to foster a better understanding of the development plans while listening to all the parties involved. Stopping the flood of news to the media from both sides is needed.

All participants decided to continue with Peace Building meetings, extending them gradually to more participants, taking responsibility to connect each other for collaboration. The circle got the new name of Peace Builders to create the bridge.

Bianca suggested as concrete proposal to gather once a week (maybe on Sunday at 5pm) all Aurovilians in Matrimandir Gardens in silence, to slowly reach again the spirit of unity and the centre we absolutely need to work as a big family for the amazing vision that Mother gave to us all. Every time we gathered in the gardens for the important celebrations, in the silence we felt truly united by the Dream and the energies that lovingly surrounded us helped us to keep alive the trust and commitment of each one in doing their part.

Let us all go back together to the Gardens to reaffirm this commitment in the silence of our hearts!

And it doesn't matter if at the beginning we will be few; the second time maybe others will feel the call inside. Until one day we will surely be able to take each other by the hand in a great circle of love, singing together the joy of having finally found ourselves and being understood in our precious diversities that create the wonderful uniqueness of Auroville.

IAC CALLS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL AUDIT

of Auroville's current, future plans

An article has appeared in the Times of India revealing that The members of the International Advisory Council (IAC) of the <u>Auroville</u> Foundation have urged the Governing Board of the Auroville Foundation to conduct a thorough <u>environmental audit</u> by independent experts of current and future plans of the Foundation.

The appeal came in the wake of protests by a section of residents of Auroville against a road project by the foundation by clearing trees and residential and community buildings as per the master plan envisaged in 1999.

Given recent developments, and Auroville's outstanding work in eco-restoration for decades, which has earned it worldwide respect, a thorough environmental audit, by respected and independent experts, of current and future plans seem an urgent necessity," said the IAC members in a letter addressed to the members of the governing board.

They urged the board to utilise the expertise and experience of many experts in Auroville in the planning of the township. "A first step could be to identify common ground, such as any area of the development of the future city that stakeholders and experts will all agree on, and focus on that initially, rather than on contending issues," they said.

They called for an actual practice of inclusiveness. "...differing views and perspectives are unavoidable, yet Auroville's challenge is to bring them together and find ways to harmonise them," they said.

PRESENTATION ON DREAMWEAVING PROCESS FOR AUROVILLE

Dear Aurovilians, we would like to invite you to a community meeting at Unity Pavilion on Monday December 27th, from 4.30-6.00pm to give you all an update on our attempt to organize an inclusive collaborative planning method for the Crown through the 'Dreamweaving' process.

The holistic process will include a group of Auroville's architects, multidisciplinary experts, and members of the community, supported by the planners of the Vastu Shilpa Foundation VSF (the office of BV Doshi). The method is a step towards a Detailed Development Plan (DDP) in harmony with Auroville's ideals, and vision.

After having spoken with many Aurovillians and received the almost unanimous support of the Auroville architects to engage, this community feedback is our last milestone before starting the process.

PERSONAL STATEMENT

Although I am currently TOS and have been since October 8, I have been hearing and reading about the recent events in Auroville from multiple sources, as well as seeing pictures and video footage. Real pain, sorrow, frustration and, at times, fear are starkly visible in the images and can be felt in all the many communications I have seen. These events have left me deeply shocked and saddened, and feeling great concern for the Dream of Auroville, the Auroville that I and so many others came to try to build, grow and be a part of, to serve the spiritual call of Mother and Sri Aurobindo.

The Galaxy Concept is a beautiful one, and I am not against the Master Plan as a perspective and framework. However, I don't believe it was intended to be a fixed or static plan and it is in fact stated on pg 84 that "Although the Master Plan (Perspective 2025) indicates a time horizon of 25 years, it will neither be traditional nor static and rigid." (Full quote of the paragraph is reproduced below.) Having read the transcripts of the interviews of Roger and having a lifelong connection with Mother, I don't believe they were rigid or fixed either, as can be seen in the many available writings and documented interviews. (From an interview with Roger: "People come here to live the experience and it is from this experience that their living conditions, their environment will be created. Q. So Auroville may never be finished, then? R. Perhaps not, but that has absolutely no importance. What is important is not to build a city, it is to build, I repeat, a new humanity. Having said that, how much delay and how much time it will take, only the future will show us. I hope it will be soon!")

But for me being for or against the Master Plan is not the point. The point is how we live together, how we develop together, how we make decisions together, act together, treat each other. And the physically aggressive actions involving JCB's and busloads of police in the middle of the night and then JCB's and a large group of hired outsiders behaving like gundas during the day after an agreement had been reached, and all of this planned behind closed doors between the Secretary and Aurovilians against other Aurovilians...this is simply not justifiable. How can we claim to be aspiring and working towards an "actual human unity" and "peace and progressive harmony" while carrying out, ordering or condoning violence, aggression, threats, intimidation and literal bulldozing because of internal disagreements?

I was present at the Inauguration, I grew up in Auroville most of my childhood and have spent most of my adult life in service to the Dream, to the aims and the ideals, and have lived in all its realities, the beautiful and hopeful as well as the discouraging, disappointing and frustrating ones. I believe with all my heart and soul that this authoritarian approach using external entities to force contentious development, or anything else, is not the way for Auroville, and goes against its spirit, its aims and its ideals.

Another point I would like to address is that of participation by residents in major decision-making. I believe every resident, no matter their perspectives or opinions, should have the chance to participate and it is reasonable to expect the Working Committee to allow and support that process. Quoting pg 9, 20(1), of the Auroville Foundation Act, "There shall be a Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly which shall assist the Residents' Assembly or, as the case may be, the Governing Board, in discharging its duties under this Act." I believe the Working Committee, of which I am currently a member, is primarily accountable to the Residents' Assembly and must put aside individual preferences and positions to give the RA its voice in organized decision-making processes, even if many of Auroville's processes are still far from perfect.

Auroville, its processes and its residents are very much 'works in progress', and therefore so is the Working Committee, but it must represent the RA to the best of its ability and, ideally, try to synthesize all of the diversity of views and positions in our complex community without resorting to force.

I hope and pray that this kind of thing never happens again among us, that it is agreed that divisive forces and tactics are unacceptable in Auroville, that the deep hurt and wounds and rifts that have been caused will be acknowledged as something real and regrettable, that we can all dig deep and find a way to build the city and walk the path of an evolution of consciousness in a spirit of creativity, exploration, experimentation, flexibility, pragmatism and open-mindedness, with all our diversity and differences, while acknowledging and embracing our common love and commitment to The Mother and Sri Aurobindo.

Although the Master Plan (Perspective 2025) indicates a time horizon of 25 years, it will neither be traditional nor static and rigid. In the framework of Perspective 2025, the Planning Group would prepare a detailed Five Year Development Plan containing the priority item to be taken for development as given in Table 22. At the close of the first Five Year Development Plan, the progress would be assessed. A second phase detailed development plan would then be prepared on the basis of the feedback obtained from the field/monitoring which will be followed by further detailed development plans for subsequent years and period. THE AUROVILLE FOUNDATION ACT

as Seen by Kireet Joshi

"This particular act has been so designed that even as it is, whatever it is, you have complete freedom to develop Auroville according to the Charter of Auroville, there's nobody who can prevent you, as long as you say and you can show that you want nothing but the Charter of Auroville. You have complete freedom.

And how is this been designed? There are three provisions in the Act. We say there will be a governing body, there will be an international Advisory Council, and there will be a Residents Assembly and all the three are equal authorities. And what will be the relationship between these three bodies? The relationship is of mutuality and this word 'mutuality' is very important.

The true soul experience is an experience of mutuality. Egoistic experience is an experience which wants to throw away everybody else, egoistically, as if we have nothing to do with anybody else. Even if you try to do it, it is impossible. In this world, as Sri Aurobindo says, there are always three terms of existence: the individual, the group in which he lives, and largest group which is humanity as a whole. And nobody can get rid of these three terms. The world cannot get rid of groups and the individuals, individual cannot give up group or their largest group, and no group can exist without a membership of individuals and the largest group around. The three are inter related. There is a spiritual unity of the three, individual, groups and the largest group

Therefore, if you are really spiritually governed, you will see mutuality of the three. It is in mutuality of the three but it depends how you develop this mutuality. And Sri Aurobindo says "by no mechanical law can you attain to this mutuality". It is only when you develop true brotherhood and you exercise true brotherhood that this mutuality can be experienced and can be realised. Now, this Auroville Act has been so enacted that, whether you like it or not, you are bound to develop brotherhood. It's a kind of a gift. This act is of such a nature that you are bound, even if you want to throw away brotherhood, you are bound to have it, it's like a spiritual compulsion. It is laid down that Auroville will be organised by the people of Auroville. Secondly that the freedom of individuals in Auroville, as long as they develop according to the Charter, nobody can infringe it, not even Governing Board. Governing Board, of course, has the power of control, supervision, to see that everything is run smoothly and, particularly, that it is bound to promote the ideals of Auroville. This fundamental heavy responsibility assigned to it ensure that the aims of the Charter are fully promoted and implemented.

The most important function of the International Advisory Council is to advise and to make sure that the freedom of the members of Auroville is guaranteed. This is the function of the Advisory Council. If the Governing Board takes any arbitrary action by which the freedom of Auroville is infringed, if you can prove that this action infringes the freedom of Auroville to promote the Charter of Auroville, it can be knocked downed. So you can see the mutuality. The Governing Board has to salute the Residents Assembly, has to give assurance to the Advisory Council that its actions are not arbitrary, Residents Assembly has to salute the Governing Board—nothing wrong in saluting anybody. This is the called mutuality, saluting each other is a fundamental law of life. To egoism, this kind of a salute is very difficult to digest. Why should I salute anybody in the world? But so long as we live in that consciousness, we are not acting according to the Charter of Auroville."

HELPFUL HINTS/ADVERTISEMENTS

AYURVEDIC RECOMMENDATIONS FOR WINTER



Visarga Kaala, when the moon is more influential and the sun rays are soft and warm.

The body gets some rest from the past seasons. The digestive fire becomes stronger, appetite increases and slowly Kapha accumulates strength and builds up the immunity. There's a feeling of coming back to the warmth of one's inner place. If imbalanced, it may give a sense of emptiness in the heart, dullness in the mind or feeling depressed or lonely (Vata or Kapha imbalances).

Help the body to regenerate: KEEP AGNI STRONG – in the abdomen for an optimum nutrient assimilation and in the heart for clarity and joy.

What kind of digestive fire do you have? VATA digestive fire:

 Irregular, weak appetite, can easily skip meals, Irregular digestion, tendency to gas, bloating, constipation. Favour tastes such as sweet, sour and salty

PITTA digestive fire:

Strong appetite, must eat when hunger manifests, otherwise becomes irritable. Fast digestion, acidity before meals, tendency to loose motion Favour tastes like sweet, bitter, astringent and use green fresh aromatic herbs: parsley, coriander, rosemary...

KAPHA digestive fire:

Weak appetite but really enjoys food. Slow, heavy digestion, tendency to create mucus or post-digestive acidity.
 Favour all spices, bitter and astringent tastes

General Guidelines In The Food:

- Sweet, sour and salty tastes
- Eat warm, cooked food spiced up with: ginger, pepper, turmeric, cumin, clove, asafoetida, mustard seed, ajwain, cinnamon, fennel seed, fenugreek seed, onion, garlic
- Proteins: Mungdal, black gram (Maasha) beans, chickpeas, lentils, white meat, egg, mutton (meat soup), nuts and seeds, spirulina, hemp seeds
- Vegetables: green leaves, carrot, beet, eggplant, cauliflower, broccoli, bitter-snake-bottlegourd, moringa (drumstick), chow-chow
- Sweet = Cereals: millets, wheat, barley, rice, oats
- Sweet = Fruits: apple, banana, papaya, passion fruit, pomegranate, grape, guava, pear, rosella, all citrus preferably sweet
- Ghee or sesame oil, olive, sunflower, apple cider vineaar
- Beverages: herbal masala teas, hot water, with honey or jaggery; wine prepared with jaggery (called Arishtam), sugarcane juice, golden milk
- Ayurvedic blend to stimulate absorption: Trikatu (for Kapha), Hingwashtak churna (for Vata), Avipatikar churna (for Pitta)... with honey

To Avoid:

- Cheese, yogurt, curd, lassi at dinner (they should be eaten for breakfast or lunch)
- Cold beverages
- Raw vegetables
- Heavy and difficult to digest (deep fried food, etc.)
- Ice-cream

In The Activities:

- Main principle: stabilize, centre, recharge
- Sleep longer
- Keep a regular rhythm (with meals and bedtime)
- Massage with sesame oil + apply heat to let the oil penetrate
- Hot shower or bath, Foot bath with warm salty water
- Keep the body warm with cotton, wool, silk, leather
- Physical exercise: 30 minutes daily of stimulating Yoga, Pranayama, Meditation-concentration, Qi-Gong, Toning...
- Nasya: 1 drop of Anu Tailam in each nostril

To Avoid:

- Prolonged fasting
- Humid and cold air, wind, fan
- Long hours at the computer
- · Stay awake late at night





How to Whiten Sheets in 4 Simple Steps

Frequently Asked Questions

If you're looking to make your sheets white again, keep reading for answers to some common questions about whitening yellowed sheets.

• Can I Get Sweat Stains Out of Sheets?

The Book Of Love, Canto 1-3

The Destined Meeting Place, Satyavan and Satyavan and Savitri. Duration: 32min.

Savitri had traveled for months the earth, passed through many cities and crossed rivers and plains in order to find her mate and to take up her unfinished divine task. Everything is led by the Omniscience, and events take place at the appointed place and time. Unknowingly she has come near her goal. Savitri's road leads up to a highland world where the air is soft and delicate, the surroundings green and delightful. She is surrounded by high mountain peaks. A gentle breeze stirs meadows of flowers.

In a sunlit recess upon the forest verge a single narrow path runs straight as an arrow amongst the giant trees. There Savitri gets her first sight of the one for whom she has come so far. At first, she sees him simply as a part of the beautiful scene, but suddenly her heart looks at him and recognises the one who is nearer to her than her own heart-strings.

All in a moment was surprised and seized,... / A mystic tumult from her depths arose;... /

Swept through the turmoil of her bosom's space... (p.395) Savitri reins in the horses, and the chariot stops. Her inner vision recognises his eyes from her past, eyes that have claimed her soul and known through many lives. Satyavan's soul responds and he turns to this vision of beauty like the sea to the moon and adores a new divinity in things. Gaze met close gaze and clung in sight's embrace. (p.396)

Then Satyavan speaks first to Savitri and asks her name. Musing she answered, "I am Savitri, / Princess of Madra. Who art thou? What name / Musical on earth expresses thee to men? (p.402) Satyavan tells her about the blindness and exile of his father, King Dyumatsena, and about his own life in the forest amongst the wild birds and animals. In Nature he felt a divine touch and a call but had not been able to touch the World-Mother's feet.

I glimpsed the presence of the One in all./ But still there lacked the last transcendent power.../ O golden princess, perfect Savitri,.../ Descend, O happiness, with thy moon-gold feet/

Enrich earth's floors upon whose sleep we lie. (p.405, 406, p.408) Her fathomless soul looked out at him from her eyes; / Passing her lips in liquid sounds it spoke..../ "O Satyavan, I have heard thee and I know;/ I know that thou and only thou art he." (p.409)

Savitri comes down from her chariot and gathers an armful of flowers from the forest-verge with which she weaves a simple garland. Before the sun, their witness and marriage-fire,

The wedding of the eternal Lord and Spouse / Took place again on earth in human forms: /

In a new act of the drama of the world / The united Two began a greater age. (p.411)

Satyavan shows to her his parent's hermitage and her future world. Savitri is happy and tells him that her heart will stay here, but that she will swiftly return to Madra to inform her father Aswapati about her meeting and her choice.

A meditative film of Huta's paintings illustrating passages from *Savitri* read by The Mother and accompanied by her own organ music which can connect us to the Divine Presence within and lead us towards the spiritual truth and New Consciousness.
