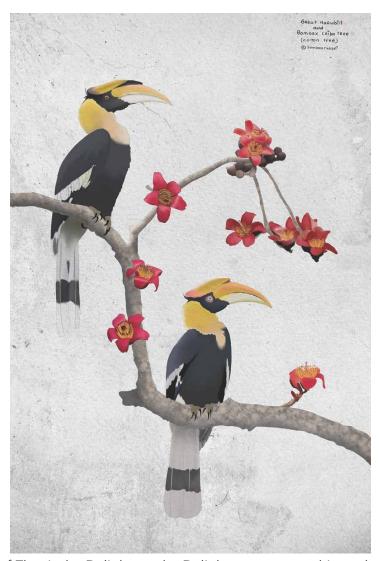

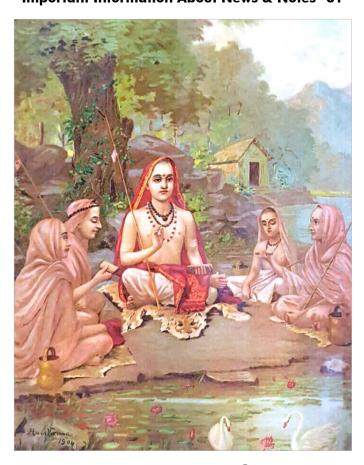

February 3, 1962 (continued from last week)

"Satprem: I would like to ask you something about my japa (the continuous repetition of a mantra)... Do you feel it's getting me anywhere? Is there any sense to it?

Mother: That's what I have been studying these past two days – not for you in particular, but the general effect of japa, the reason for it in the organization of one's life... I can't say I have made any discoveries (maybe for myself, I don't know); but my study is not on higher levels, it's right here.

It would take too long to give the details; I can summarize, but I don't want to make a doctrine, and for it to be living it's bound to be long.

For some time now I have been running into difficulties with my morning japa. It's complex. I won't go into details, but certain things seemed to be trying to interfere, either preventing me from going on to the end, or plunging me into a kind of trance that brought everything to a halt. So I began wondering what it was and why. A very, very long curve was involved, but the result of my observations is the following. (All this is purely from the body's standpoint; I mean it doesn't concern the conscious, living, independent being that would remain the same even without the body – to be exact, the being whose life, consciousness, freedom and action do not depend on the body. I am speaking here of that which needs the body for its manifestation; that alone was in question.)

There has been a kind of perception of a variety of bodily activities, a whole series of them, having to do exclusively (or so it seems) with the maintenance of the body. Some are on the borderline - sleep, for instance: one portion of it is necessary for good maintenance of the body, and another portion puts it in contact with other parts and activities of the being; but one portion of sleep is exclusively for maintaining the body's balance. Then there is food, keeping clean, a whole range of things. And according to Sri Aurobindo, spiritual life shouldn't suppress those things; whatever is indispensable for the body's well-being must be kept up. For ordinary people, all other bodily activities are used for personal pleasure and benefit. The spiritual man, on the other hand, has given his body to serve the Divine, so that the Divine may use it for His work and perhaps, as Sri Aurobindo said, for His joy - although given the present state of Matter and the body, that seems to me unlikely or at best very intermittent and partial, because this body is much more a field of misery than a field of joy. (None of this is based on speculation, but on personal experience - I am relating my personal experience.) But with work, it's different: when the body is at work, it's in full swing.

That's its joy, its need – to exist only to serve Him. To exist only to serve. And of course, to reduce maintenance to a bare minimum while trying to find a way for the Divine to participate in the very restricted, limited and meager possibilities of joy this maintenance may give. To associate the Divine with all those movements and things, like keeping clean, sleeping (although sleep is different, it's already a lot more interesting); but especially with personal hygiene, eating and other absolutely indispensable things, the attempt is to associate them with the Divine Presence so that they may be as much an expression of divine joy as possible. (This is realized to a certain extent.)

Now where does japa fit into all this?

Japa, like meditation, is a procedure – apparently the most active and effective procedure – for joining, as much as possible, the Divine Presence to the bodily substance. It is the magic of sound, you see.

Naturally, if there's also an awareness of the idea behind it, if one does japa as a very active CONSCIOUS invocation, then its effects are greatly multiplied. But the basis is the magic of sound. This is a fact of experience, and it's absolutely true. The sound OM, for instance, awakens very special vibrations (there are other such sounds as well, but of course that one is the most powerful of all).

It is an attempt to divinize material substance.

From another, almost identical point of view, it fills the physical atmosphere with the Divine Presence. So time spent in japa is time consecrated to helping the material substance enter into more intimate rapport with the Divine.

And if one adds to this, as I do, a mantric program, that is, a sort of prayer or invocation, a program for both personal development and helping the collective, then it becomes a truly active work. Then there's also what I call "external" work: contact with others, reading and answering letters, seeing and speaking to people, and finally all the activities having to do with the organization and running of the Ashram (in meditation this work becomes worldwide, but physically, materially, it is limited for the moment to the Ashram).

In the course of my observation, I also saw the position of X and people like him, who practically spend their lives doing japa, plus meditation, puja (a ritual or ceremony to invoke or evoke a deity), ceremonies (I am talking only about sincere people, not fakers). Well, that's their way of working for the world, of serving the Divine, and it seems the best way to them – perhaps even the only way – but it's a question of mental belief.

In any case, it's obvious that even a bit of... not exactly puja, but some sort of ceremony that you set yourself to do - habitual gestures symbolizing and expressing a particular inner state - can also be a help and a way of offering yourself and relating to the Divine and thus serving the Divine. I feel it's important looked at in this way - not from the traditional viewpoint, I can't stand that traditional viewpoint; I understand it, but it seems to me like putting a brake on true self-giving to the Divine. I am speaking of SELF-IMPOSED japa and rules (or, if someone gives you the japa, rules you accept with all your heart and adhere to). These self-imposed rules should be followed as a gesture of love, as a way of saying to the Divine, "I love You." Do you see what I mean? Like arranging flowers in a certain way, burning incense, dozens of little things like that, made beautiful because of what is put into them - it is a form of self-giving.

Now, I think that doing japa with the will and the idea of getting something out of it spoils it a little. You spoil it. I don't much like it when somebody says, "Do this and you will get that." It's true – it's true, but it's a bit like baiting a fish. I don't much like it.

Let it be your own manner of serving the Divine, of relating to Him, loving Him, of joining Him to your physical life, being close to Him and drawing Him close to you – that way it's beautiful. Each time you say the Word, let it be an invocation, let it be like the recitation of a word of love; then it's beautiful.

That's how I see it.

And so according to your mission in the world, you have to find for yourself the right proportion between this work and external, intellectual or organizational work; and then there are the body's needs, which can be met in the same way, trying to make it possible for the Lord to take delight in them. I have seen this for trivial things: for example, making your bath a pleasant experience, or caring for your hair, or whatever (of course, it's been a long time since there have been any of those stupid, petty ideas of personal pleasure), so that these things aren't done indifferently, out of habit and necessity, but... with a touch of beauty, a touch of charm and delight for the Lord.

There, that's all....

Mon petit... (Mother gazes a long time at Satprem).

For me, you know, japa means a moment when all physical life is EXCLUSIVELY for the Divine. A moment when nothing but the Divine exists – every single cell of the body, each second, is EXCLUSIVELY for the Divine, there is nothing but the Divine.

When you succeed in doing that, it's good.

Japa shouldn't become so exclusive that it's done twenty-four hours out of twenty-four, because then it's equivalent to asceticism – but there should be a good dose of it.

It's almost the one luxury of life – that's how it feels to me. The luxury of That alone, nothing but that divine vibration around you, within you, everywhere. Nothing but the divine vibration.

Now, that's luxury.

Voilà, mon petit..."

integral part of the PWG document (<u>'Participatory Working Groups'</u> & the selection process of their members).

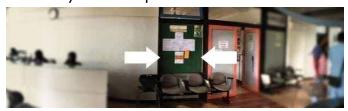

UPDATE ON L'AVENIR D'AUROVILLE / ATDC



Dear Residents of Auroville, Development Council we are restructuring l'Avenir d'Auroville/ Auroville Town Development Council in order for

us to meet the requirements of a planning office capable of building the City of Auroville, to become a professional office having effective technical teams that can realise the building of Mother's City as per the Galaxy Plan and Master Plan.

This is an important change of its functioning, as, compared to the past decades, the pace of the work needs to speed up immensely as must its quality increase.

Practically this means that the technical teams will be expanded and the planning office will take up more space in the ACUR building. We have engaged many people for the technical team both from inside and outside Auroville. When our teams are complete we will publish a list of names of those who work at ATDC and an updated list of members.

ATDC will focus on many things including planning, development of Urban Design Guidelines for every sector/ zone, creation of DDPs with internal teams and external consultants, preparation of projects, implementation and monitoring of projects, surveys and mapping, resource mobilisation and much more.

While we are doing so, almost all of our time is taken up by making sure we first and foremost get settled in a new way of functioning. A lot of personal requests for buildings, extensions and renovations are reaching us, and we understand that some of you have been waiting for several weeks/months. We are attending to these individual applications in the midst of this bigger work for the building of the City which, at the moment, takes precedence over everything else.

We are undertaking in the near future several surveys in the city area and the green belt; we thank Aurovilians in advance for allowing our ground team to do their job.

Here are some updates on some topics:

- 1. Some requests for individual houses and extensions are presently on hold, as the DDP only can show where development is in line with the Master Plan. Those applications which are on hold will be communicated individually.
- 2. As part of the Master Plan implementation, we are working on opening up Residential Zone Sectors 1 and 2 for new residential projects of varying densities, along with some projects that will be located in outside Master Plan areas where land and infrastructure are available. If you are already on the list with Housing Service, then you will be contacted when a corresponding project starts. We request people with Project Holder capacities to write to ATDC as we are currently forming a pool of Project Managers that can help with various aspects of realising the projects in these 2 sectors.

We know that many people are requesting stewardship agreements for the houses that were built without any NOC's or approvals. The fact that this unclarity exists is part of the need for restructuring and a full clean-up of AT-DC's records. We will not be issuing retroactive NOCs for the assets built without NOC. Once we have the base map and the corresponding information fully updated, these old issues will be looked into and dealt with case by case.

3. The ATDC has together with the Auroville Foundation approved 4 special projects as priority projects: Morning Star, Mother's Flower Garden, Svaram Musical Research Centre and The Sprout. More information will be published shortly as and when available to us.

We are grateful and immensely happy to finally have a real impetus to realise Mother's City, and hope that all of us are enjoying this beautiful development.

FOLLOW-UP RA MEETING

in Preparation for a Decision-Making on the Selection Process Proposal

Dear Residents, below you find the report of the Residents' Assembly Meeting (RAM) that happened on Monday 28th of March 2022 and all relevant materials.

Follow-up Residents' Assembly Meeting

Day/Date: Monday, 28.03.2022,

Venue: Unity Pavilion

Time:4 to 6pm

Attendees: 90 attendees (in person in UP) and 25 online participants

Facilitator: Julia

The follow-up RAM on this topic was held by the Residents' Assembly Service (RAS) to inform about and discuss the proposal in preparation for the decision-making process. You can find the RAM recording here.

90 confirmed Aurovillians attended the meeting at Unity Pavilion. Newcomers, volunteers, and youth below 18 were also welcomed, as stipulated in the RAD policy, as silent observers. People started to register their attendance from 3:40pm on. The RA Meeting started at 4:05pm.

The RA Meeting:

- 1. The RAM was formally opened at 4:05pm by the facilitator with a welcome and a moment of silence. The facilitator set the intention, and the ground rules and got through the agenda;
- 2. Residents' Assembly Service members welcomed the participants of the meeting and informed about the stages that the RAD process consists of;
- 3. Martin and Philippe (members of the Selection Process Review Task Force) presented an updated version of the proposal on a modified method of selecting members for the major working groups;
- 4. The Task Force reps presented a data analysis of the 121 survey responses and 18 inputs shared via email, with feedback on the original proposal, that RAS received from the community, explaining what they did consider for the revision, what they did not, and why;
- 5. After the presentation the facilitator encouraged the attendees to ask questions on the proposal and share their inputs;
- 6. The RAS explained how to express agreement or disagreement on the revised proposal and suggested voting options to those physically present in the room (by a show of hands) and those connected online (using YouTube poll);
- 7. The majority expressed a common agreement to accept the refined proposal to be put out to the community for a decision; and use "YES"/"NO" voting option;
- 8. As per the RAD policy, the RAS will soon "disseminate an RAD announcement (along with the proposal, voting options and all relevant materials), containing a personalised voting link, through the RAS mailing system 2 weeks prior to the voting deadline. The same announcement will be published in News and Notes and Auronet";
 - 9. The RA meeting was closed at 6pm.

Topics discussed:

Revelation: Cristo remains the caretaker, Jean- Luc takes care of the fruit orchard, Olivier operates the financial service account, Nathalie does the accounting, Arun takes care of the daily management of the place and Ancolie is joining the Educative Forest project. She will be working with Arun and Patrick.

Nedaal aka the Ridge top sanctuary: Needal is a 15-acre plot at the center of the Northern Forests of Auroville. Because of its geographic location at the top of a large watershed, it has been established as a wildlife breeding ground and sanctuary forest. Sekar is requesting stewardship of this plot. The forest group could not take a decision as the decision lies with the concerned NFA stewards who were absent in this meeting. All the NFA collective forest stewards are dearly invited to attend the next meeting.

Nilatangam: As per Ambre's request, Forest, a young Canadian volunteer, announced that he will take care of Nilatangam during Ambre's absence with Ancolie's support.

Evergreen: Bernardo, a young Argentinian, who is in the process of becoming Aurovilian, has joined the Evergreen working team.

The Sprout: A survey has been carried out on the 1st of April, 2022, to mark the Sprout location 2, along with the Radial. The location has changed and needs to be reviewed. The forest group has written an email dated 13th of March, 2022, which has been ignored, as has the feedback from the community for this project. The forest group maintains their position to support development in this area as per community process and a detailed developmental plan that is made in consultation with all concerned parties including both the forest group and a community elected TDC.

Infinity: Vikram C-S has reported that fencing and bunding work has been done on two of the three outlying plots of Infinity, as well as within the main community area. Planting has been achieved on one of these plots which has currently a very low forest cover and within the community area. A lot of mining had been happening in the areas around Infinity, which had made it tricky to traverse. Now the access has been changed with the friendly willingness of the neighbors. Furthermore access via 4 wheelers needs substantial work to be viable throughout the yearly seasons. Work within the community is mainly focused on the upkeep of the fruit orchards as well as creation and upkeep of the kitchen gardens. Vikram C-S is requesting a half maintenance to help support the future work there.

The next meeting will be in Hermitage on Friday, 6 May.

PASSING ON

ERIC RAMANUJAM



On 19 March this year, Eric Ramanujam passed away at the age of 58 in PIMS where he had been taken due to advanced jaundice. While perhaps not having met him in person, many of us know his beautiful and educative wild life stone paintings placed in Pitchandikulam, at the visitors walk way to VC, as well as at the ECR toll plaza. Starting out at Aranya in 2000, where he studied, drew and wrote

about the Indian Horned Eagle for several years, he later moved to Pitchandikulam where he was employed as wildlife biologist. His detailed, gentle drawings, combining black and white ink with colour, are found in scientific articles, books and papers all over India. A detailed obituary by India's Sanctuary Nature Foundation can be found here below. Thank you, Eric. May you be in peace. OM

Artist for Wildlife and Nature deeply mourns the death of senior wildlife illustrator and owl researcher Eric Ramanujam! Eric was very supportive of AWN's initiative's and easy to approach. He was readily reachable giving his inputs and suggestions on any project. One of the first artist to come forward to display his artworks in the annual show in 2017.

Eric was employed by Pitchandikulam, a unit under Auroville Foundation, as a Wildlife Biologist. He has a background in the Advertising Industry (which he left because of the skull duggery and deadlines he, as junior staff, had to endure) and took to autecological / behavioural studies of the Indian Eagle Owl and associated nocturnal predators and prey in 1997. Since 2002 he has undertaken field studies of the Kaliveli wetland complex (near Pondicherry), Adyar wetland complex (in Chennai) and Shevroy Hills of the Eastern Ghats. In Pitchandikulam he created an 'Art Collective' – a group of wildlife/nature artists/illustrators working together to manifest outputs on a commercial scale. So far, the collective has been successful with working with Government departments (for example, Chennai Rivers Restoration Trust on the Adyar Eco Park and Gulf of Mannar Biodiversity Reserve Trust), Corporates (like WIPRO Technologies) and many NGOs (for example WWF-Delhi) in addition to quite a few private clients. This initiative is our major foray into a 'studio based' culture.

Eric Ramanujam authored "In Achilles' Footstep – Adventures with The Indian Eagle-Owl". Brilliant illustrations and in-depth knowledge sharing on Owls of India.

His last paper was on Wildlife art and illustration – combining black and white ink drawings in the Threatened taxa Magazine. Link to his paper can be read here.

Eric was Mammal Category Award Winner of 2017 Artists for Wildlife and Nature Annual show.

His contributions to nature, art, science and his love for owls will live forever!

TREATMENT OF THE NEEM TREES affected by Dieback disease

Dear Community, we are grateful to the response of many to the initiative to help in the treatment of the Neem trees affected by Dieback disease (caused by fungus Phomopsis Azadirachtae, that has been observed on neem trees across the region. Leaves of the affected trees dry and turn brown and slowly the trees die.)



We (Margarita's team & Island's volunteers) are now in the crusade of saving the Neem trees affected by Dieback. According to the plant pathologists from TN, AP, Telangana and Karnataka, we are losing neem trees at the rate of 10 -15% per year. Many Aurovilians believe that the Neems are OK, "they will come back and so on", but those who think that can answer me two questions?

- do you have data of how many fruits produce your
- how much capacity of fruiting has lost your neem tree through the past years affected by Dieback disease?,

Neem trees are crucial for many reasons. One of them is canopy and freshness for summer times. The root system is totally symbiotic with neighbouring plants and grasses. Neem needs less water but distribute it well as it can increase soil aeration and water holding capacity of near soils.

Today science is having better tools thanks to modern imaging equipment that allow us to see at microscopic level the microbiome of soil – water – human skin – human gut, etc. PROBACILL is the result of that science's advanced tools.

In this regard, Probiotics House is prioritizing the stock of C4 compost available ONLY for neem tree treatment and not for any pots plants and gardening as was mentioned before. If the actual C4 compost finishes, we will make efforts to bring more from TATA's C4 compost but the price is different. The other idea is to bring awareness that communities can make their own C3 compost, but this matter is another time to explain.

Once again follow the attached link and videos and presentation for ways to know what should be done.

Microbiome: A microbiome is the community of microorganisms that can usually be found living together in any given habitat.

C3 compost from wet waste: Raw waste peels, food garbage, suitable wastes, that enhance their suitability for application to the soil as a fertilizing resource, after having undergone composting.

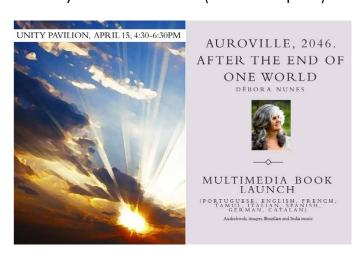

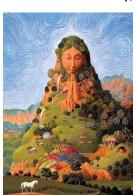

Enea and Ofa's son, Niran, needs regular treatments for his medical condition that cost up to 50,000 rupees per month. The Health Fund covers as much of that as they can with lots of goodwill, but Enea and Ofa have to cover the rest while also supporting themselves and their 2 other children and keeping their community, Miracle, going. In February, when Niran tested positive for Covid, the treatment costs went up substantially for the month because they had to be given in the isolation ward.

Any financial gifts that can be given, in any amounts, would be a great help to them, not just practically but so they feel the support and care from their Auroville family.

They have not asked me to make this appeal for them but they are aware that I am doing so.

Clarification: the Health Fund covers the maximum amount that is allowable under the current guidelines, which is already a huge help, and for which they are extremely grateful. There are still some expenses such as alternative therapies and treatments that are not covered under the Health Fund guidelines and it is for these expenses that they need additional help.

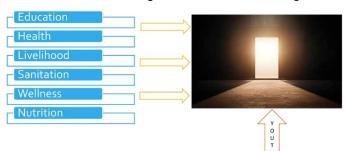
CONCEPT NOTE VĀCAL "DOORWAY"

Trees tangled up in global politics

In Auroville the relation between humans and trees has been contentious, with some authorities calling out Acacia species as aggressive



invaders, while others suspect forest stewards of making a quick buck by secretly selling timber. Where else in the world would trees turn political? Well, it seems: in Europe.

The European Tree of the Year is an annual contest held to find the most 'loveable tree' in Europe. The competition by the Environmental Partnership Association (EPA), an organization supported by the European commission, was founded in 2011 to celebrate the histories of old trees and develop relationships between nations around a topic that was seemingly as neutral as anything could be: trees... Most of the 15 countries (16 with Russia) that participated in the competition this year held a national contest to select the year's entry. The winner is submitted to the Europeanwide competition, and then members of the public vote for their two favorite entries on the European Tree of the Year website. Nearly 770,000 votes were cast this year. The winner is announced at an awards ceremony in late March held in the EU Parliament, Brussels. In more recent years, a #TreesInNeed blog has been promoted by the contest organisers to highlight the plight of numerous trees across Europe under threat of destruction. Most winning are trees from Eastern Europe – maybe because the West has already cut most of its old trees.

Polish oak called Józef won the Crown

Oak Jozef (Quercus robur) from Poland won last year, with 17 thousand votes. It gave shelter to a Jewish family during World War II. The oak's image was also printed on the Polish 100 złoty bill. Oak Józef receives



many visitors. On behalf of Oak Józef, an official of the District Council, received the unique wooden rolling trophy that passes from winner to winner every year. (It is not clear what Józef got out of the whole deal).

This year, with the war escalating in Ukraine, even a competition dedicated to celebrating trees found itself unable to remain separate from global politics...

In one of the latest examples of symbolic efforts to isolate Russia from the rest of the world, the group in Brussels disqualified Russia's candidate – an oak tree planted by novelist Ivan Turgenev 198 years ago. The organizers of the competition, one of the largest competitions devoted to trees, said in a statement that they cannot stand idly by and watch the unprecedented aggression of the Russian leadership against a neighbouring country.

This year Poland won the award again. This time it was a 400 year old oak tree, which the organizers felt symbolized Polish resistance to aggression and a warm welcome to refugees from Ukraine. The tree lives in the <u>Bialowieza</u> forest, the last primeval forest in Europe's lowlands, a UNESCO World Heritage site which stretches across the border of Poland and Belarus. It has been the site of fierce protests against logging, <u>which remains highly controversial</u>. On top of this, construction workers began work on a 115-mile, 18-foot metal wall through the forest, intended to block migrants, mostly from the Middle East and Africa,

from crossing into Poland from Belarus. When the candidates were announced in early February, the tree was a symbol of the protest against the wall, said Josef Jary, one of the organizers.

The second place in the competition went to a 250 year old oak tree in the Santiago de Compostela region of Spain while the third place was bagged by a 250 years old cork oak tree in Vale do Pereiro in Portugal.

THE IDEAL OF HUMAN UNITY

Nothing is more obscure to humanity or less seized by its understanding, whether in the power that moves it or the sense of the aim towards which it moves, than its own communal and collective life.

Chapter I: The turn Towards Unity

Nothing is more obscure to humanity or less seized by its understanding, whether in the power that moves it or the sense of the aim towards which it moves, than its own communal and collective life. Sociology does not help us, for it only gives us the general story of the past and the external conditions under which communities have survived. History teaches us nothing; it is a confused torrent of events and personalities or a kaleidoscope of changing institutions. We do not seize the real sense of all this change and this continual streaming forward of human life in the channels of Time. What we do seize are current or recurrent phenomena, facile generalisations, partial ideas. We talk of democracy, aristocracy and autocracy, collectivism and individualism, imperialism and nationalism, the State and the commune, capitalism and labour; we advance hasty generalisations and make absolute systems which are positively announced today only to be abandoned perforce tomorrow; we espouse causes and ardent enthusiasms whose triumph turns to an early disillusionment and then forsake them for others, perhaps for



those that we have taken so much trouble to destroy. For a whole century mankind thirsts and battles after liberty and earns it with a bitter expense of toil, tears and blood; the century that enjoys without having fought for it turns away as from a puerile illusion and is ready to renounce the depreciated gain as the price of some new good. And all this happens because our whole thought and action

with regard to our collective life is shallow and empirical; it does not seek for, it does not base itself on a firm, profound and complete knowledge. The moral is not the vanity of human life, of its ardours and enthusiasms and of the ideals it pursues, but the necessity of a wiser, larger, more patient search after its true law and aim.

Today the ideal of human unity is more or less vaguely making its way to the front of our consciousness. The emergence of an ideal in human thought is always the sign of an intention in Nature, but not always of an intention to accomplish; sometimes it indicates only an attempt which is predestined to temporary failure. For Nature is slow and patient in her methods. She takes up ideas and half carries them out, then drops them by the wayside to resume them in some future era with a better combination. She tempts humanity, her thinking instrument, and tests how far it is ready for the harmony she has imagined; she allows and incites man to attempt and fail, so that he may learn and succeed better another time. Still the ideal, having once made its way to the front of thought, must certainly be attempted, and this ideal of human unity is likely to figure largely among the determining forces of the future; for the intellectual and material circumstances of the age have prepared and almost impose it, especially the scientific discoveries which have made our earth so small that its vastest kingdoms seem now no more than the provinces of a single country.

But this very commodity of the material circumstances may bring about the failure of the ideal; for when material circumstances favour a great change, but the heart and mind of the race are not really ready — especially the heart — failure may be predicted, unless indeed men are wise in time and accept the inner change along with the external readjustment. But at present the human intellect has been so much mechanised by physical Science that it is likely to attempt the revolution it is beginning to envisage principally or solely through mechanical means, through social and political adjustments. Now it is not by social and political devices, or at any rate not by these chiefly or only, that the unity of the human race can be enduringly or fruitfully accomplished.

It must be remembered that a greater social or political unity is not necessarily a boon in itself; it is only worth pursuing in so far as it provides a means and a framework for a better, richer, more happy and puissant individual and collective life.

A SELF-CHOSEN VISION IN ACTION

Here is a clear Vision of the Supramental realisation from our Avatar founders Sri Aurobindo and the Mother, and the Work needed, the Action, the necessary conditions, for the receptive and willing Aurovilians, the transitional beings, as they move on inwardly and outwardly towards the Divine Manifestation, the promised salvation in the awakened physical, the birth of the New Man that by then has evolved beyond human beings or Homo sapiens, the new apex species the Supramental being: how many generations or churnings of the human instruments and the environment this will take is all up to the Divine:

"As I have often been questioned about it, I shall touch briefly on the meaning of true humility, supramental plasticity and spiritual rebirth. Humility is that state of consciousness in which, whatever the realisation, you know the infinite is still in front of you. The rare quality of selfless admiration about which I have spoken to you is but another aspect of true humility; for it is sheer arrogance that refuses to admire and is complacent about its own petty achievements, forgetting the infinite which is always ahead of it. However, you need to be humble not only when you have nothing substantial or divine in you but even when you are on the path of transformation. Paradoxical though it may sound, the Divine who is absolutely perfect is at the same time absolutely humble - humble as nothing else can ever be.

He is not occupied in admiring Himself: though He is the All, He ever seeks to find Himself in what is not-Himself that is why He has created in His own being what seems to be a colossal not-Himself, this phenomenal world. He has passed into a form in which He has to discover endlessly in time the infinite contents of that which He possesses entirely in the eternal consciousness.

One of the greatest victories of this ineffable humility of God will be the transformation of Matter which is apparently the most undivine. Supramental plasticity is an attribute of finally transformed Matter. The supramental body which has to be brought into being here has four main attributes: lightness, adaptability, plasticity and luminosity. When the physical body is thoroughly divinised, it will feel as if it were always walking on air, there will be no heaviness or tamas or unconsciousness in it. There will also be no end to its power of adaptability: in whatever conditions it is placed it will immediately be equal to the demands made upon it because its full consciousness will drive out all that inertia and incapacity which usually make Matter a drag on the Spirit. Supramental plasticity will enable it to stand the attack of every hostile force which strives to pierce it: it will present no dull resistance to the attack but will be, on the contrary, so pliant as to nullify the force by giving way to it to pass off. Thus it will suffer no harmful consequences and the most deadly attacks will leave it unscathed. Lastly, it will be turned into the stuff of light, each cell will radiate the supramental glory. Not only those who are developed enough to have their subtle sight open but the ordinary man too will be able to perceive this luminosity. It will be an evident fact to each and all, a permanent proof of the transformation which will convince even the most sceptical.

The bodily transformation will be the supreme spiritual rebirth—an utter casting away of all the ordinary past. For spiritual rebirth means the constant throwing away of our previous associations and circumstances and proceeding to live as if at each virgin moment we were starting life anew. It is to be free of what is called Karma, the stream of our past actions: in other words, a liberation from the bondage of Nature's common activity of cause and effect. When this cutting away of the past is triumphantly accomplished in the consciousness, all those mistakes, blunders, errors and follies which, still vivid in our recollection, cling to us like leeches sucking our life-blood, drop away, leaving us most joyfully free. This freedom is not a mere matter of thought; it is the most solid, practical, material fact. We really are free, nothing binds us, nothing affects us, there is no obsession of responsibility. If we want to counteract, annul or outgrow our past, we cannot do it by mere repentance or similar things, we must forget that the untransformed past has ever been and enter into an enlightened state of consciousness which breaks loose from all moorings. To be reborn means to enter, first of all, into our psychic consciousness where we are one with the Divine and eternally free from the reactions of Karma. Without becoming aware of the psychic, it is not possible to do so; but once we are securely conscious of the true soul in us which is always surrendered to the Divine, all bondage ceases. Then incessantly life begins afresh, then the past no longer cleaves to us. To give you an idea of the final height of spiritual rebirth, I may say that there can be a constant experience of the whole universe actually disappearing at every instant and being at every instant newly created!"

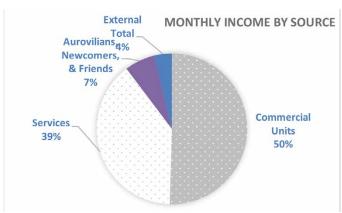
